2. How can you re-align your focus with Jesus’ mission? (see Col. 3:2)

Group Discussion

3. In what ways does unity among Christians help others see Jesus more clearly? Where do you see disunity harming our mission, and what could you personally do about it?
4. What’s the difference between unity and uniformity?
5. What are some non-essential areas where we need to show liberty and charity instead of division?
6. Have you ever hesitated to share your faith out of fear it wouldn’t “work”? What does it look like to faithfully share and leave the outcome to God?

Plan of Action

7. What would change in your week if you woke up each day with the mindset: “I am on a mission today”?
8. What specific relationships or spaces has God placed you in to be His witness?
9. Action Step: Identify one “mission moment” you’ll commit to this week—e.g., showing kindness, having a spiritual conversation, inviting someone to church.
