#### Reflection

1. Can you share a funny or personal moment when something didn't make sense to you at first, but later turned out for the best?

#### Group Discussion

Read Judges 6:11–12. Gideon was hiding, yet God called him a “mighty warrior.”

2. Why do you think God called him that, even though he was afraid?
3. How does this encourage you about how God sees you?

Read Judges 7:2–7. God reduced Gideon army from 32,000 to 300.

4. What do you think the people felt when their numbers kept shrinking?
5. What does this teach us about God's power versus human strength?

Read Judges 7:16–20. Instead of swords, God used trumpets, torches, and jars.

6. Why do you think God chose such unusual weapons?
7. What are some “unusual” ways God has worked in your life?
