Questions for the Community

Personal Reflection

- Abundance (John 10:10): Am I truly living in the abundance Christ offers, or am I settling for less? Explain!
- Guidance (John 10:3–4, 27/ Heb. 13:20–21): Do I recognize and follow the Shepherd's voice daily, or do other voices lead me? How do you hear His voice in your walk with Jesus?
- Mission (John 10:11,15,17–18 / 2Cor. 5:15): How am I laying down my life for others in response to Christ's sacrifice for me personally?
- Security (John 10:28–29): Do I rest in the assurance that no one can snatch me from Christ's hand, or do I struggle with fear and doubt? If so, how so?

Group Discussion

1. What does "abundant life" look like in practical terms for us as believers today?
2. How can we discern the Shepherd's voice and know His will together as a community, especially in noisy Silicon Valley?
3. In what ways does Christ's self-giving sacrifice shape our mission as a church?
4. How does the promise of eternal security change the way we face trials and suffering together as a family?
5. Which of these four aspects (abundance, guidance, mission, security) do you feel our group needs to grow in most, and why?

Plan of Action

Daily Practice: Commit to spending intentional time listening to the Shepherd's voice in Scripture and prayer each day this week.

Missional Step: Identify one concrete way to lay down your life for someone else — serving, giving, or encouraging — as an act of Christ-like sacrifice.

Meditation Step: Write John 10:28–29 on a 3x5 card & carry it with you as a reminder of your eternal security in Christ.

(Read it aloud 4 times a day for 7 days, meditate on it, and you will have it memorized without trying)
