Daily Devotional for God's Navigation System

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or discuss it together with your Christian friends.

January | 29

Be Connected.

READ OUT LOUD

Proverbs 3:5 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding."

- Last weekend, Pastor Whitcomb gave three important nuggets we need to know about God's Navigation System: Information, Transformation, and Destination. Which of these nuggets was a discovery to you? Why did you choose your answer?
- How does one establish a good connection with God? Share your experience about how you connected with God with a Christian friend.

FAITH DECLARATION: "I trust in God with my whole heart. I hold firm to His promises. No matter what my circumstances look like in the natural, I know He is working things in my favor."

PRAYER OF FAITH: "Father, I thank You for the assurance in Your Word. I know that I am safe in You. I am at peace because You know all things. Give me knowledge through Your Word to know You and Your ways. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen."

January | 30

Stay on Route.

READ OUT LOUD

Proverbs 28:26 "Those who trust their own insight are foolish, but anyone who walks in wisdom is safe."

- Last weekend, Pastor Whitcomb said, "Direction doesn't come when you search for direction. Direction comes when you search for GOD." What does this statement mean to you?
- We have various tools we use as humans to aid us in finding directions: The solar system, maps, GPS, etc. List the tools we can use to stay on route with God.

FAITH DECLARATION: "I do not trust in my insight but trust in God's foresight for me. His wisdom is my light and safety. Therefore, I won't be ashamed."

PRAYER OF FAITH: "Dear God, I fix my eyes on You because You are wisdom. Always guide me with Your truth that I may not walk my own way and fall. Teach me Your ways that I may be wise, in Jesus' name. Amen."

Where Are You Now?

READ OUT LOUD

Psalm 139:1-5 “O Lord, You have examined my heart and know everything about me. You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I’m far away. You see me when I travel and when I rest at home. You know everything I do. You know what I am going to say even before I say it, Lord. You go before me and follow me. Every day of my life was recorded in Your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed.”

- Pastor Whitcomb taught, “The answer is not information – the answer is God”. What does this statement mean to you? How is God the answer you need? Discuss this with a Christian friend.
- If you turn on your GPS to get to Accra, but it navigates to Lagos, then your GPS is useless. God’s guidance takes you from where you are to a glorious future destined for you. On a scale of 1-10 with 1 being the least and 10 being the best, where are you now in your relationship with God?

FAITH DECLARATION: “The Lord is great! He sees, hears, and knows all that I do. He knows where I am now. Therefore, I will not fear!”

PRAYER OF FAITH: “Sovereign Lord, You see all, hear all, and know all things about me. Every moment of mine is laid out before You. I know You can rescue me from where I am. Help me by Your Spirit to navigate through this life’s journey. In Jesus’ name I pray. Amen.”

February | 1

Submission.

READ OUT LOUD

Proverbs 3:6 “In all your ways submit to Him, and He will direct your paths.”

- Pastor Whitcomb said, “Information is NOT the only factor in seeking direction to your destination. We must submit to God and yield to Him.” What does this statement mean to you?
- What does it mean to submit to God? How can you practice submission to God today?

FAITH DECLARATION: “The Lord is my Lord; I submit to Him. My ways are secured because I align my plans and purposes to His authority.”

PRAYER OF FAITH: “Heavenly Father, I thank You for Your guidance. I put my hope and future in Your hands because You are the master planner and executor. I submit myself under Your mighty hand. Lead me in all Your truth. In Jesus’ name I pray. Amen.”

February | 2

Steady Transformation.

READ OUT LOUD

Psalm 37:31 “They have made God’s law their own, so they will never slip from His path.”

- Pastor Whitcomb said, “You won’t arrive at the right destination by knowing information. You will arrive at the right destination by submitting to GOD.” What do you make of this statement?
- What did Pastor Whitcomb mean when He spoke of “Transformation”? What are the benefits of transformation through God’s word?

FAITH DECLARATION: “God’s word is my law; I won’t be moved. God’s word is the light on my path; I won’t slip.”

PRAYER OF FAITH: “Heavenly Father, I thank You for Your transforming word. Like David, I have made Your word the law of my heart. Help me by Your Spirit to keep in step with Your will so that I will grow into the person You desire me to be. I ask this in Jesus’ name. Amen.”

February | 3

God's Delight.

READ OUT LOUD

Psalm 37:23 "The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives."

- Consider what God is telling you today: "Every detail of your life is in God's view and interest. He is concerned about every detail. God cares more about your direction and destination than you do!" With this knowledge in mind, what are you willing to do to keep your trust in Him? When you seek God and submit to Him, your arrival at the right destination is guaranteed.

FAITH DECLARATION: "I trust in God with all my heart. His direction for me is accurate, and His destination for me is excellent. He delights in every detail of my life."

PRAYER OF FAITH: "Lord, I thank You for the blessed Holy Spirit, who You have set as a guide for me in my life's journey. I submit wholeheartedly to His leadership and instruction. I know He will show me the right path. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen."

February | 4

God's Positioning System.

READ OUT LOUD

Psalm 119:105 "Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path."

- God's word is true. God is faithful, and God is the GPS you need in your life.
- In his sermon summary last weekend, Pastor Whitcomb said, "God's information plus your transformation will lead you to the right destination." What does this truth mean to you? How will you apply the above statement in your life?

FAITH DECLARATION: "Your word is right and true for me; it illuminates my path always. Therefore, I rejoice in my position in You."

PRAYER OF FAITH: "Lord, I thank You for Your word which brings light and direction to my life. Constantly lead me by Your word, which always brings me to You. You are all I ever needed. Help me find my complete safety and satisfaction in You. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen."
