Into the Unknown: A Study of Exodus Reflection questions –Exodus 3:1-4:17

What are some experiences you had when you were younger that led you to where you are now?

What is something that God "caught you looking at?" (a time when God got your attention)

Moses' initial objection to the task that God was calling him to was to question his own identity. God's answer was "I am with you." How does the promise that God is with you shape your sense of identity? How does it help you be brave?

What are the names of God that are most significant to you in your life? Why?

What is one of your "what if" questions that keeps you from following God into the unknown?

In what ways is Moses heading "into the unknown" at the end of this passage?

After reading this long section of Exodus what do you know about God? Why does that matter?
