Reflection Questions for Exodus 11:1 – 13:16

The instructions in 12:2 included a kind of new calendar – life would start anew for the Israelites. What events in your life orient your calendar? For example: "That happened when we were living in Texas."

God's deliverance for Israel comes with a cost – the sacrifice of lambs. In what ways do you see the costliness of salvation in the Bible?

Part of the Passover instructions are to continue to "tell the story" to future generations. Why is this important? What are the stories of faith you have been told?
