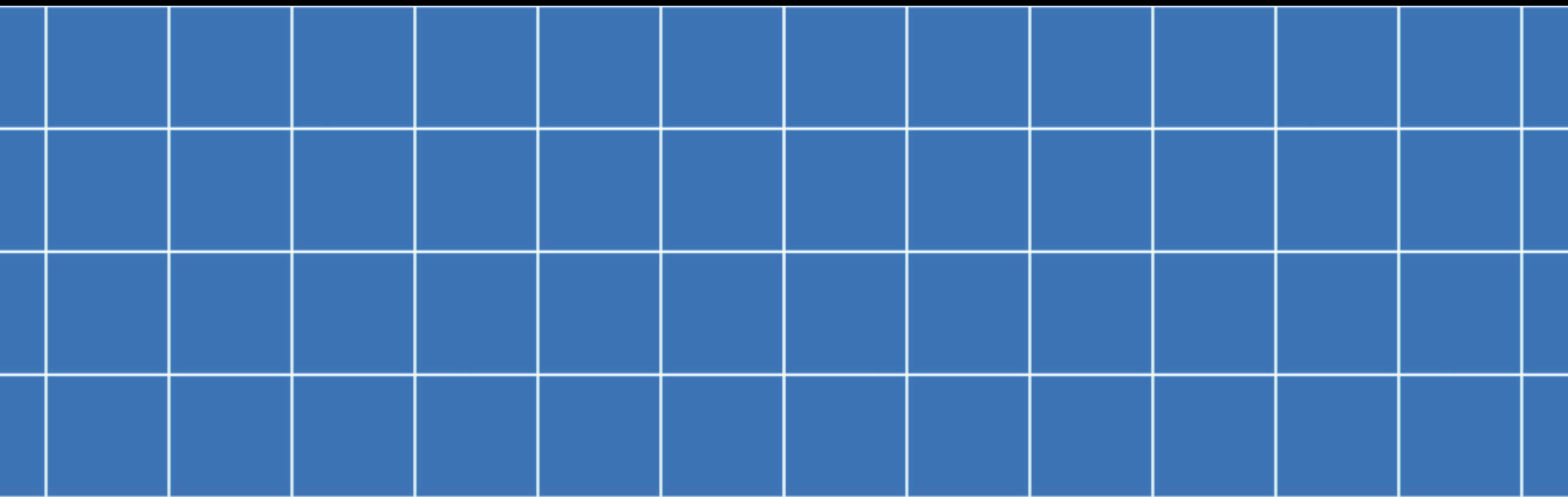

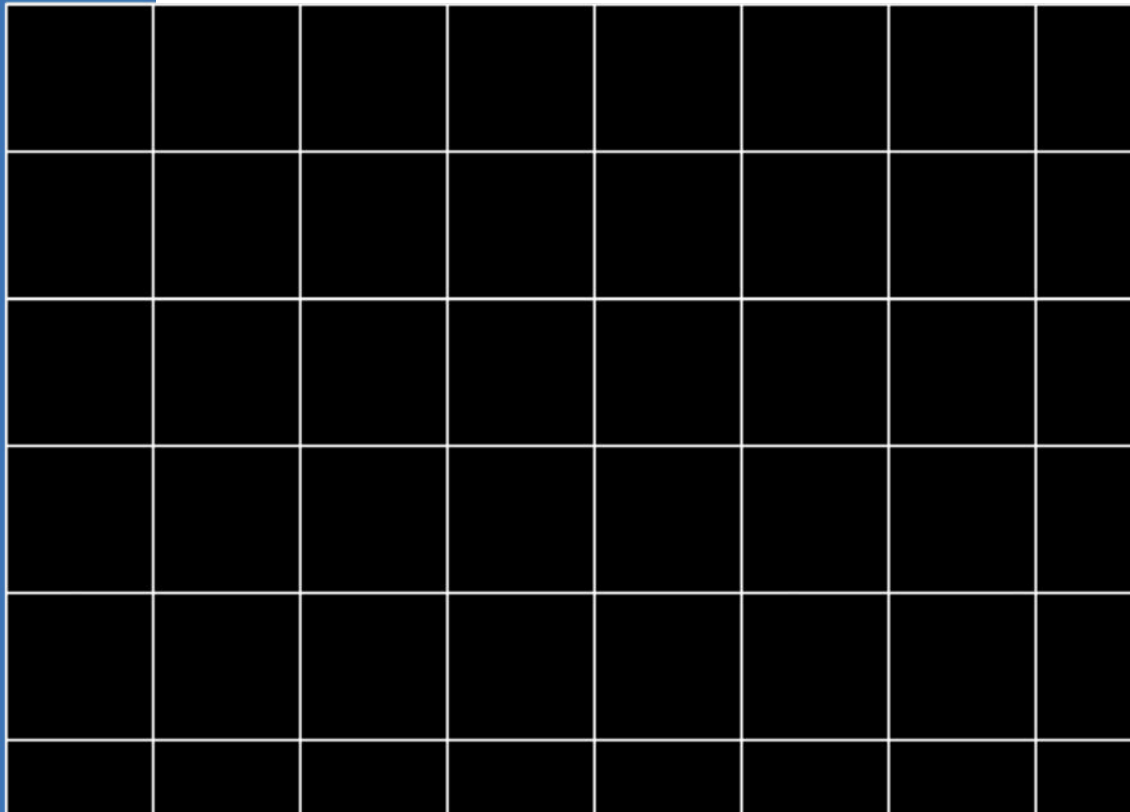

Let's be **UNSTOPPABLE!**

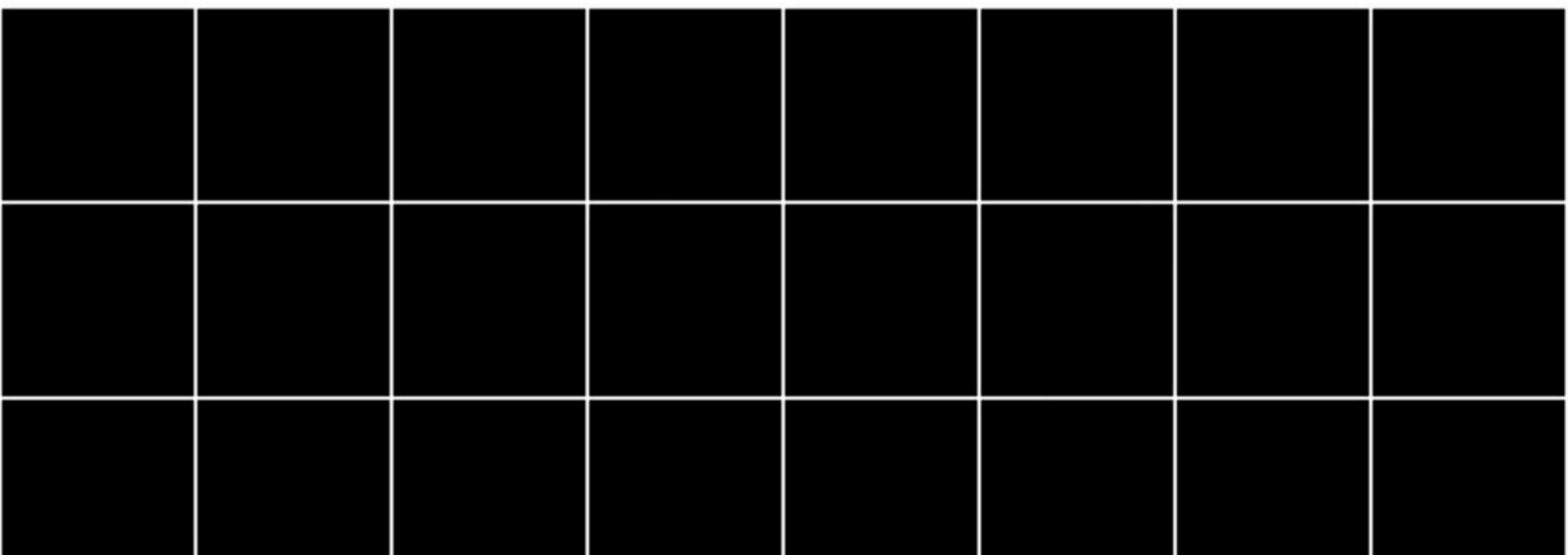

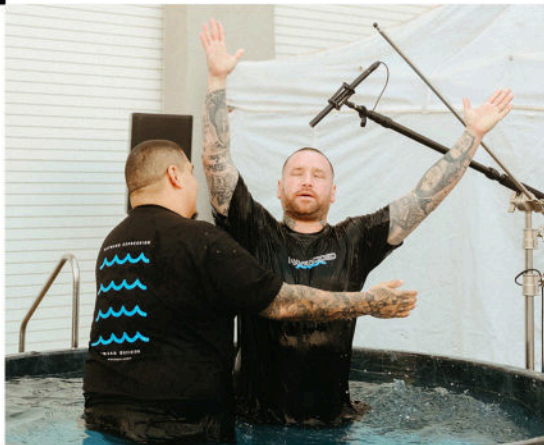

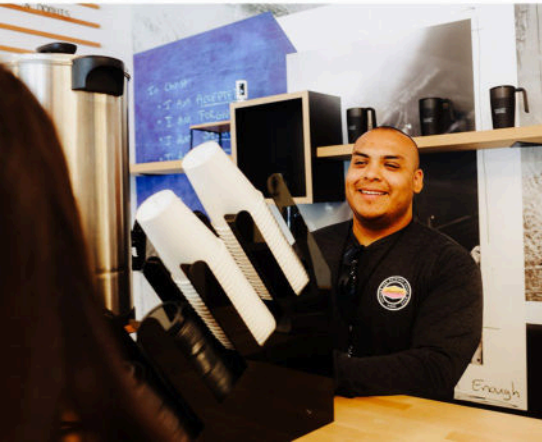

Discovery Church focuses on spiritual growth and also cares for mental health. They're proud to open a Christian Counseling center.





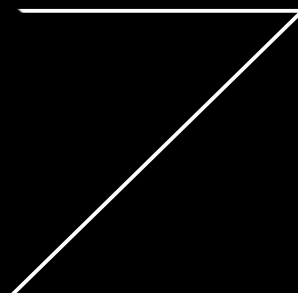
# UNSTOPPABLE FAITH

HERE ARE FOUR SPECIFIC STEPS THAT WE ASK  
YOU TO TAKE:

1. **PRAY:** Pray that God would multiply our efforts to make disciples and make much of Jesus. Pray that He would do abundantly more than we ask or imagine for His great name.

2. **FULLY PARTICIPATE:** Help us reach our goal of 100% engagement through UNSTOPPABLE.

Stand side by side with your church family. Commit to do what God asks and go all in. Make plans now to support the vision by committing to being at services from September 10 through October 8.

3. **CHEER LOUDLY:** Own the UNSTOPPABLE vision and become a cheerleader for it within your spheres of influence. Engage in the UNSTOPPABLE study with your Small Group.

4. **GIVE GENEROUSLY:** Ask God to show you what it looks like to give in a way that changes you, and take whatever steps are required to see it through.


## NEXT STEPS

### ONE FUND INITIATIVE

You may have been part of church campaigns in the past where you were asked to give a second gift 'above and beyond' your usual gifts to complete special projects. At Discovery these have been used to make new buildings and ministries possible. Normally, you gave that gift to the "Building Fund" and you also continued to give to the "General Fund." This type of giving is potentially confusing to people who either don't have a baseline for their "usual giving" or who aren't able to really celebrate the total giving at Discovery in one single number. We believe we're all on ONE MISSION - the mission of navigating people to God.

Instead of giving toward multiple funds (tithes, offering, legacy, dream center, etc), we will be combining all generosity toward one, UNSTOPPABLE initiative fund for the next two years. This will include fulfilling our everyday ministry mission (budget) as well as the future vision we are moving toward.

## THE GIVING JOURNEY

### INITIAL GIVER - 2 Corinthians 8:7-15

An Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time in response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trusts both God and church leaders with their gift.

### CONSISTENT GIVER - 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to give something and gives it consistently to exercise the discipline of regular giving. Often, this is someone who determines to give a recurring gift online at. Those who do not give online can become consistent givers, also, but doing so requires more discipline.

### INTENTIONAL GIVER - Luke 14:28-35

An Intentional Giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize and spend their money. The point of intentionality may occur when someone begins to tithe (10% of your gross income).

### SURRENDERED GIVER - Colossians 1:15-18, 22-23

A Surrendered Giver is someone who recognizes the price Christ paid for them on the cross and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. Their giving governs their spending and saving rather than their spending and saving governing their giving.

### ETERNAL GIVER - 1 Timothy 6:6-19

An Eternal Giver is someone who is thinking about the longer tail of generosity rather than just the shorter term of month-to-month generosity or even year-to-year.

An Eternal Giver makes decisions in the short term that have longer term effects as it relates to their generosity capacity. They think of what home they buy, what car they purchase, how much savings they choose to keep, all in relation to their generosity capacity. An Eternal Giver is driven by the things of eternity, putting their hope in God and not in the things of this earth.

# UNSTOPPABLE CHURCH

## WEEK 1 : COMMUNITY GROUP GUIDE

### REFLECT

1.) Read Proverbs 29:18 KJV | Proverbs 29:18 NIV | Job 42:2 GW | Ephesians 3:20 LB: Pastor Jason shared four destinations we can reach through God, our church, and our connection to authentic community. Collectively "we" fulfill God's Will and plans together:

- Love God: 2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV
- Find Freedom: James 5:16 NIV | 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 | Galatians 5:1 NIV
- Love Each Other: John 13:35 NIV | 1 John 1:7 NIV
- Change the World: Mark 16:15 ESV

· Do you relate to God as a loving Father or something else? (What can you do intentionally to further develop your relationship with God? Love God)

· Pastor Jason explained that that not all strongholds get broken at the moment of salvation: Where do you feel like you need freedom most; your thoughts, your habits, your emotions, your relationships? (Is there an area of your life that you haven't surrendered to God? Why? Find Freedom)

· Examine the closest people in your life: What are they influencing you to become or do? (How can you intentionally develop authentic God-honoring relationships? Love Each Other)

· Pastor Jason said the goal of the initiative is 100% participation and that everyone would encounter Jesus in the area of their finances and possessions. Will you commit to inviting Jesus into your finances and ask how He wants to use you to further His Kingdom? (Change the World)

2.) Read Proverbs Matthew 16:18 NIV: Pastor Jason shared Seven Factors of an Unstoppable Church:

- Clear Vision
- Divine Focus
- Authentic Community
- Supernatural Power
- Hearts Focused Outward
- Innovative Minds
- Committed Givers

As you examine each of the seven factors, which of the seven are you actively living out to make a difference? (Note how many factors you tallied up.)

How many of the seven factors could you make a difference in if you were to engage in and share the collective vision of your church? (Note how many factors you tally up and compare that number with question 1. Where do you gain the most impact from, no-participation, limited-participation, my participation, all of our participation?)

### APPLY

God makes it clear in His Word that He has great "vision" for each of our lives. We come from a great God! It stands to reason that He would also produce great children if we would just do what He says. For us to achieve the greatness God has purposed for our lives, we have to come to a point in time where we surrender our hands and will to achieve His Will. His design is each of us, with Him, under His authority living through His Word. We need to realize we don't achieve Godly greatness alone nor do we do it absent a focused and intentional effort on our part. We achieve God Worthy achievements as a family "under" the power of His Word and "through" the authority He has ordained and given each of us. All of us will be given opportunities to contribute to a legacy worthy of our time. If we do it right, not only does it glorify God, but it benefits others, and it gives us a hand in doing something that God truly values and will honor. We too are the beneficiaries of our own generosity as we submit to living our lives for God. We see an example of what men and women of God can do as we examine Nehemiah and how he led the construction that rebuilt the fallen wall in Jerusalem. Rebuilding the wall wasn't possible by a few, but united as many under God's purpose and plan, the wall was collectively rebuilt in a remarkable 52 days!

Clear Vision, Divine Focus, Authentic Community, Supernatural Power, Hearts Focused Outward, Innovative Minds, and Committed Givers is the winning formula for "US" to be an Unstoppable Church. We can do great things for God and the people He loves by collectively making His priorities our priorities. When God provided our savior in Christ Jesus, He wasn't thinking of the "temporary" cost and sacrifice to Himself or to Christ. He was thinking of the "eternal" benefits to us. Who are you thinking of? Now that you know, commit to taking the steps that God reveals for you to take.



**WEEK 1 : PRAYER DEVOTIONAL****UNSTOPPABLE CHURCH**  
**Sept 10th- 16th**

As a church, we are embarking on a 28-Day Prayer Devotional. This has the potential to dramatically change your life and the culture of our church. Commitment Sunday is on October 8th. For that reason, we want to pray each day beginning on September 10, 2023, asking God to move in a mighty way in the hearts and minds of the people that call Discovery Church home. Whether you can pray for 1 minute or 20 minutes, we believe there is power when God's people unite in prayer and that God is able to do far more than we can ever imagine. Join us on this Unstoppable Prayer Journey for the next 28 days!

"Now glory be to God, who by his mighty power at work within us is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of—infinately beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes." Ephesians 3:20

**Day 1 - Clear Vision**

Today as we start this Unstoppable journey, we pray for a fresh revelation of your vision for our lives and for our communities. Open our eyes, Lord, to see beyond our immediate circumstances and to grasp the purpose and calling you have placed upon us. Help us to understand the significance of seeking your will and following your commands. We commit our lives, our plans, and our dreams into your hands. May your vision become our vision, and may we walk in obedience to your Word. Let your light shine through us, impacting our families, our communities, and the world around us.

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint; but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction.

**Day 2 - Divine Focus**

Father, we acknowledge that our ways are flawed and imperfect. We acknowledge our need for your guidance in every aspect of our lives—our relationships, our work, our dreams, and our aspirations. We surrender our plans and ambitions to you, trusting that you will guide us on straight paths that honor you. May our lives be a testimony to your faithfulness and goodness as we walk in divine focus today.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.

**Day 3 - Authentic Community**

Lord, today we pray for the cultivation of authentic community within our church, our families, our neighborhoods, and our relationships. May we be intentional about fostering an environment where genuine love, acceptance, and accountability thrive. We recognize the temptation to isolate ourselves or to become complacent in our

relationships. We ask for your grace and guidance to overcome these tendencies and to prioritize gathering regularly. Give us hearts of compassion, that we may come alongside one another, offering support, and encouragement in authentic community. Hebrews 10:24,25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

### Day 4 - Supernatural Power

Today we pray for a fresh outpouring of your Holy Spirit upon us. Activate your power within us, Lord, that we may be vessels through which your supernatural works are manifested. Increase our faith, that we may trust in your ability to do immeasurably more than we can ask or imagine. Lord, we declare that we are ready and willing vessels for your supernatural power. May your glory be revealed through us, drawing others to you and impacting lives for your Kingdom. Ephesians 3:20 Now glory be to God, who by his mighty power at work within us is able to do far more than we would ever dare to ask or even dream of—ininitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, or hopes.

### Day 5 - Hearts Focused Outward

We come before you today with open hearts and a desire to align ourselves with your heart for the world. Help us to see people as you see them—precious, loved, and in need of a Savior. Give us sensitivity to the spiritual hunger and thirst that exists in the lives of those around us. Give us the words to speak, the actions to demonstrate, and the love to pour out, that others may be drawn to you. Mark 16:15 And he said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.

### Day – 6 Innovative Minds

Lord, we ask that you open our minds to new possibilities, perspectives, and ideas today. Remove any limitations or preconceived notions that hinder us from embracing innovation. We come before you with grateful hearts, acknowledging your wisdom and creativity as the ultimate source of all innovation. We recognize the importance of renewed minds and the impact they can have in bringing forth new ideas, solutions, and breakthroughs as we become an Unstoppable Church. May our innovation be marked by integrity, humility, and a heart of service. Guard us against the temptation to use our gifts solely for personal gain, but instead, help us to use our innovative abilities to promote your Kingdom. Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

### Day – 7- Committed Givers

Lord, we thank you for the gift of generosity. Help us to understand that giving is not merely an act of obedience or obligation, but a reflection of your character and love. Teach us to give sacrificially, selflessly, and without reservation, trusting that you will multiply and bless our gifts. Thank you, Lord, for the opportunity to participate in your work of transforming lives through giving. May our commitment to give reflect our love for you and our desire to serve others. Use our gifts, no matter how big or small, to make a difference in the lives of those around us. Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over, will be poured into your lap.



## WEEK 2 : SERMON NOTES

## UNSTOPPABLE COMMUNITY

**REFLECT**

1.) Read Hebrews 12:1-2 and Genesis 2:18 NIV: Pastor Jason identified four roadblocks to community:

- Relational Wounds: Philippians 3:13-14 NIV
- Personality: Proverbs 18:1 ESV
- Perspective: Romans 12:4-5 NIV
- Busyness: Psalm 127:1-2 NIV

Personally examine each roadblock: (Do any of these roadblocks exist for you or others in your family? Why and how did they get there? How can you push through the barriers?)

- Are you settling for a corrupt and perishable benefit by allowing a roadblock, or will you push through the barrier(s) so you can receive God's eternal blessings?

- What needs to happen in your life for the roadblock(s) to be removed?

- When you think about living life God's Way opposed to living life your way, which way do you think is eternally better and why?

2.) Read Acts 2:42-46 NIV: Pastor Jason made the point that, "God doesn't want you to just "attend", He wants you to "belong". God wants the church to grow larger and smaller at the same time."

Why do you think belonging has been designed into each of us as an "integral" need?

What do you think it means for the church to grow larger yet smaller at the same time? (As a church body we steadily grow in numbers but our Small Groups stay small. Everyone is known and everyone is seen. Our ability to achieve Godly goals grows as we grow.)

3.) Read Romans 12:5 NIV: Pastor Jason said "Jesus didn't ask people to join His Bible study, He asked them to join His team: 1st Corinthians 3:9 TEV. A Christian without a local church is a Spiritual Orphan: Matthew 16:18 NLT." Pastor Jason provided four commitments to an unstoppable community:

- Committing to a church and choosing to belong.
- Committing to friends and choosing to be authentic. (Sharing your experiences, your homes, and your pain.) Proverbs 27:17 TEV, Acts 2:44 LB, 1st Peter 4:9 NCV, Galatians 6:2 NLT, Matthew 25:40 NRSV
- Committing to a team and choosing to do my part.
- Committing to stewardship and recognizing God's ownership. Psalm 24:1 NIV

What do you think "each" commitment can produce in your life if you stay faithful to your commitment?

Can we be in a family if we intentionally orphan ourselves from the family God intended for us to have?

What does a true commitment mean to you? (Can you truly commit if you change your mind or allow it to be changed by other people, life circumstances, or personal preferences and desires?)

Pastor Jason shared the giving pyramid. Where do you think you fall within the giving pyramid?

What level of generosity is God calling you to reach? (How do you get there?)

**APPLY**

A greater good is accomplished through the unity of community. We can accomplish more as a family than we ever could as individuals. We reach God sized goals together. What steps do you need to take? What roadblocks do you need to eliminate? What's keeping you out of community? Do you need to forgive someone to heal the wounds? Maybe become less selfish? Maybe become eternally minded over being carnally minded? Do you need to commit to God's calling by surrendering to how He designed each of us to serve, love, and obey Him? We get from point "A" to point "B" by taking the right steps to get there. Identify the steps you need to take then commit to taking them faithfully into the foreseeable future.

**WEEK 2 : PRAYER DEVOTIONAL****UNSTOPPABLE COMMUNITY****Sept 17th- 23rd****Day – 8 - Roadblocks to Community**

We recognize that there are often roadblocks that hinder us from experiencing the community you desire for us. Lord, we pray for the removal of roadblocks that hinder genuine community within our church. We also ask for a spirit of transparency and vulnerability within our communities. Break down the walls of self-protection and fear that prevent us from truly knowing and being known by others. Help us to create safe spaces where honesty, authenticity, and support thrive.

Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

**Day 9 - Relational Wounds**

Lord, we bring before you the pain, hurt, and brokenness caused by broken relationships, betrayals, misunderstandings, and conflicts. We acknowledge that these wounds can be deep and long-lasting, affecting our ability to trust, love, and engage in healthy relationships. We surrender our relational wounds into your hands, trusting in your power to bring healing, reconciliation, and transformation. May our lives be a testimony to your grace and the power of your love to restore what is broken.

Philippians 3:13-14 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

**Day 10 - Personality**

We humbly come before you, recognizing the potential roadblock that our personalities can sometimes pose in building authentic and thriving community. As we reflect on the wisdom of Proverbs 18:1, which warns against isolating ourselves and acting against sound judgment, we seek your guidance and grace to overcome any hindrances our personalities may present. Father, we ask for your wisdom and transformation in our hearts and minds. Help us to recognize and address any negative tendencies or behaviors within our personalities that hinder healthy relationships. May our personalities be shaped by the fruit of the Spirit, leading us to demonstrate love, kindness, patience, and humility.

Proverbs 18:1 Whoever isolates himself seeks his own desire; he breaks out against all sound judgment.

**Day 11 - Busyness**

Lord, help us to set healthy boundaries and to say no to the demands and pressures that lead to overwhelming busyness. Remind us that our value and worth are not defined by our productivity, but by our identity

as your beloved children. Father, we ask for your grace to release our anxieties, worries, and busyness at your feet. Help us to trust in your provision, knowing that you are the one who sustains us. In a world that often pressures us to conform, to settle for mediocrity, and to pursue worldly success, we ask for your strength and wisdom to resist those temptations. Help us to align our hearts and desires with your perfect will and to trust in the plans you have for our lives. Give us the strength to step out in faith, even when the path is uncertain or challenging. Teach us to rely on your guidance and to surrender our own desires and plans to you. We lift up to you any areas of our lives where we may have settled for less. Fill us with a desire to continually seek your will and to strive for excellence in all we do.

### Day 13 - Choosing to Belong

**WEEK 3 : COMMUNITY GROUP GUIDE****REFLECT**

1.) Read Colossians 1:11-12 and Galatians 6:9 NIV:  
Pastor Jason shared several perspectives to help us push through the difficulties of life that we're likely to experience at some point in our lifetime:

- Don't be surprised by adversity: (Jesus tells us in John 16:33 NLT that on earth we will have trials and sorrows. But to take heart because he has overcome the world.)
- Look for ways God might use it for good:

God shakes things up to inspect me: Jeremiah 17:10 NIV & Deuteronomy 8:2 NIV, correct me: Hebrews 12:8-11 CEV & Hebrews 12:26-27 LB, direct me: Proverbs 16:9 GW & Proverbs 20:30 GNT, protect me: Job 36:16 NLT & Genesis 50:20 NLT, and perfect me: 1st Peter 5:10 NIV & Romans 5:3-4 LB.

- Trust God for what I don't understand: Proverbs 20:24 LB & Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV

Visit each of the three perspectives. Share how you think a person might incorporate each perspective into one's lifestyle to live it out in truth. (Be sure to visit "each" of the five ways God uses adversity for good. Explore "why" and "how" each way is necessary for us to "accept" and "surrender" to for our own growth and health as Children of God.)

**APPLY**

God created every one of us for greatness. We serve a sovereign all powerful God who creates life and manifests creation with His spoken Words. As Children of God, we are all destined to do great things, not because we're great but because God is! There IS power in God's Word! We fulfill greatness in our lives collectively, "under" God's authority, and "through" our obedience to Him. When we obey God, we unleash the power of His Unstoppable Word in our lives. What's getting in the way of your obedience to God? What legacies could you leave that honor God and those He loves if you would just obey Him? God so loved the world that He allowed a part of Himself to die just to save the people He loves. Just because our lives may have challenges doesn't disqualify any of us from doing our part to manifest God's Will on earth as a "member" of His family. A little bit from each member of the body under the authority of God's Word makes us unstoppable! God meant for us to be a family and to work together as a family. Isolation, individualism, or competing ideologies that are misaligned with God are enemies to unity, greatness, and the collective achievement God would have us fulfill. Identify the barriers in your life. Tear down the roadblocks that are preventing your movement to a Godly destination. Start living the truth that God's Word declares. Being unstoppable is not about our comfort. Being unstoppable is about our obedience to God. Living an unstoppable life isn't about the one, the 10, or even the 100. Living unstoppable lives is about the body of Christ coming together united with God so we can live and achieve as "one".

### Day 15 – Inspect Me

You see into the depths of our hearts, understanding our motives, thoughts, and desires. We know that our hearts can be deceitful and prone to wander from your ways. We invite you to inspect us, to reveal anything within us that is not aligned with your will. Shine your light into the hidden corners of our hearts and minds, revealing any areas of sin, pride, selfishness, or unbelief. Convict us by your Spirit and lead us to repentance and transformation.

Jeremiah 17:10 I the LORD search the heart and examine the mind, to reward each person according to their conduct, according to what their deeds deserve.

### Day 16 – Correct Me

We come before you with hearts open and humble, recognizing our need for your correction and guidance. As we reflect on the words in Hebrews which remind us of the discipline and correction you provide as a loving Father, we invite you to correct us and shape us according to your will. We trust in your wisdom and guidance to correct us. We surrender ourselves to your transformative work, knowing that your correction is rooted in love and designed for our growth and maturity. Help us to embrace correction with humility and a teachable spirit.

Hebrews 12:8-11 God corrects all his children, and if he doesn't correct you, then you don't really belong to him. Our earthly fathers correct us, and we still respect them. Isn't it

even better to be given true life by letting our spiritual Father correct us? Our human fathers correct us for a short time, and they do it as they think best. But God corrects us for our own good, because he wants us to be holy, as he is. It is never fun to be corrected. In fact, at the time it is always painful. But if we learn to obey by being corrected, we will do right and live at peace.

### Day 17 – Direct Me

Help us to surrender our own plans and desires to your perfect plan. Give us the wisdom to discern your leading and the courage to follow it, even when it may be different from what we expect or understand. Grant us a spirit of obedience and trust as we walk in your ways. Father, we pray for clarity and discernment in decision-making. When faced with choices, reveal to us the path that brings honor to your name and aligns with your word. Direct me today.

Proverbs 16:9 A person may plan his own journey, but the LORD directs his steps.

### Day 18 – Protect Me

Guard us, O Lord, from the schemes and attacks of the enemy. Protect us from the forces of darkness that seek to steal, kill, and destroy. 1.) Pastor Jason identified a legacy as: "Something that is handed down from one period of time to another period of time." God blesses us with abundance so we can:

- Be a blessing for others. (We must know what the abundance is for.) Genesis 12:2 NLT

- When we bless others, God takes care of our needs. (There's almost nothing God won't do for the person who wants to help other people.) Luke 18:29-30 GW

- The more God blesses us, the more He expects us to bless others. Luke 12:48 LB, Deuteronomy 21:17 & Hebrews 12:22-23 NIV (Freely we have received. Freely we should give.)

God has given everyone an increase. How will you steward what He has given you?

If given a chance to leave a Godly legacy, would you say yes to the opportunity?

This past Sunday Pastor Jason revealed a Two Year Commitment Card explaining the collective impact we can make. What offering is God moving you to make above and beyond your tithe?

Does your generosity commitment align with your surrender to God's Word and leading?

Do you really have time to waste or should you take action today? (Proverbs 27:1|Luke 12:20 NIV)

2.) Pastor Jason shared The Seven Laws of Harvest:

- Everything starts as a seed. Genesis 1:11 NIV: (Who provides the seed for us to plant and nurture? God does.)

- Nothing happens until the seed is planted. John 12:24 NIV (By God's hand the seeds are planted. By our hands and through God's Word seeds are grown, nurtured, and prosper others.)

- Whatever I sow is what I reap. Galatians 6:7 NIV (Harvest does not come without planting.)

- I always reap in a different season from when I sow. Ecclesiastes 3:1-5 NIV (Reaping takes time and isn't instant.)

- I always reap more than I sow. Mark 4:8 NIV (What is your perspective as you actively plant?)

- I can increase my harvest by planting more seed. 2nd Corinthians 9:6-7 NIV & Proverbs 11:24 MSG (Where is your vision and focus as you sow?)

- I must be patient and not give up. Galatians 6:9 & Psalm 126:5-6 NIV (Who gives the increase and whom should you be trusting for the harvest after you've planted?)

Share your thoughts about each law of harvest and how one might take action to live out each law in truth: (What

is God calling for you to do to align with Him on each law?)

Is leaving a legacy optional for us as Children of God? (What does God's Word say about the slothful servant? Is he praised or punished? Christ is the Son of God. Christ is God's Child just as we are His adopted children. We are ALL subject to the Will of God. Christ modeled for us how children of God live. They give of themselves to fulfill their mission and assignment? As a child of God you do have an assignment. What's your assignment?)

**APPLY**

When we examine the life of Christ we see the model of what a life of legacy and purpose can really accomplish. What Jesus gave so long ago has reconciled countless souls, for countless generations, for thousands of years! His gifts are still reconciling souls today and bringing people closer to God. His legacy will continue to do so into the infinite future! Christ is our example of what a human life can accomplish submitted and surrendered to the Will and purpose of God. Where would we all be without Christ? Because of what Christ gave of himself in obedience to God, we now have an eternal inheritance with God in His House. Can you see the bigger picture of generosity and legacy now? Can you see that God has not demonstrated selfishness but sacrificed His all so none would be lost? Are you willing to sacrifice of yourself to fulfill a greater purpose than yourself or even your own family? Our time, talents, touch, and treasures are the assets God has given us stewardship over. Are you directing your assets in a way that benefit God's Kingdom and those He loves? What Kingdom Impact can your life have by yielding to God and His Will? Answer each question above. Write down your answers Ask God to order your steps from this point forward. Listen for what God tells you to do. Write down His direction then do it without delay, doubt, or disbelief. Without Christ each of us would have been eternally lost. Through the obedience of Christ to the Will of God, we are forever reconciled and shall forever be with God our Father. What might be lost should you choose to NOT obey God?

You gave your Son, Jesus, as the greatest gift of all for our salvation. Teach us to imitate your generosity and to give freely and cheerfully, without hesitation. Lord, break down any barriers or fears that may hinder our generosity. Remove any selfishness, greed, or attachment to worldly possessions that may prevent us from freely giving. Transform our hearts and minds to be like yours, overflowing with love, compassion, and generosity. We lift up this Commitment Sunday to you Lord, and all those who are choosing to Invest in your Unstoppable plans. Open up the flood gates of heaven and pour out your blessings today, in Jesus Name!

- The line is longer than the dot: Hebrews 11:14-16 MSG
- There's limited time and incredible opportunity: Ephesians 5:15-16
- It's smart: Matthew 6:19-21

2.) Read 2nd Corinthians 8:1-12 NIV: Pastor Jason identified five choices we can make in the truth of God's Word as it relates to our generosity.

Choose to give:

- Joyfully: 2nd Corinthians 9:7 NIV
- Selflessly: 2nd Corinthians 9:15 NIV
- Willingly: Matthew 5:17 NIV
- Intentionally, of your time, talent, touch, and treasure: 2nd Corinthians 9:7 NLT & 2nd Corinthians 9:10-11 NIV
- Thankfully: Psalm 116:12 NIV & Exodus 13:14-15 MSG

Which of the five choices can you easily live out and why? (How was your ability nurtured?)

Which of the five are more difficult for you and why? (Set a course and path to overcome)

Which of the five are you unable to live out and why? (What do you need to break through?)

**APPLY**

Our ability to nurture Unstoppable Generosity germinates "in" and is grown "through" the Word of God. The more we live out God's Word in truth, the more fulfilled our lives become. We would not have a savior had God not provided the lamb that paid our sin debts. We would not have a savior had Christ not "obeyed" the Father to his death. We would not have a path to righteousness to follow had God not inspired His Word in men and had them write it down for us to follow. We would not have God's Word had men not obeyed God to write it. God gave His Word and His Son, (A part of Himself) for US. Christ gave freely his life for "US." Men gave of their time, talents, and treasures in obedience to God. Sacrifice and unselfish love is what God and Christ have demonstrated to us. Why? Because generous sacrificial giving IS what love requires.

Evaluate your heart. Is it generous? Do you desire to be generous? Do you love those who God loves? Do you value what God values? Knowing what has been freely given to each of us inspires the desire within to become generous and freely give. We become generous because He is generous. We learn to give because He gives! We sacrifice because He sacrifices. When we fix our eyes upon the wrong things we develop a skewed perspective of truth which leads us down the wide path to selfishness. Where are your eyes looking? What are they fixed upon? We can do so much greater together by collectively following the Word of God. Will you join us?

Decide today to live God's Way. Choose to grow in Unstoppable Generosity. Follow the model God and Christ have demonstrated. Choose to sacrifice the love of self for the selfless love of God and others. We don't become unstoppable because we're unstoppable. We become unstoppable because God is unstoppable and we're aligning with Him! All we have to do is agree with God and start living out His Word in truth. Let's go!
