We at Ethnos360/New Tribes Mission have Extensive Training for people to get the Gospel to the tribal locations.

Church planting and evangelism to a thriving church once it is established. Bible Translation and Literacy helps for the literate churches.

We are thankful for the Bible School that ETHNOS360 has and this past year we had 44 graduates in the 2-year training to get to one of the 33 countries we are working in to reach people for Christ.
