Wednesday Message: “PRAYER OPENS THE DOOR!”

BIG THOUGHT:

The goal is to get people to see that Windows and Doors that God wants to open in our lives. Pastor / Rabbi Brian Bileci teaches us how “Prayer Opens the Door!,” and how we must ASK, SEEK and KNOCK for these divine doors to open. God opens doors that no man can shut!

PERSISTENCE IN PRAYER AS A THREEFOLD PROCESS:

1. **ASK** - *Pray with expectation that God will fulfill your requests as you apply His Word.*
2. **SEEK** - *Pray earnestly and effectually as you seek God's face and not just His hands.*
3. **KNOCK** - *Pray fervently and specifically as you target your prayers to God's will.*

Reading: James 4:1-3, 7-8 (NKJV)
