# NATE'S JUDGMENT

**John 1 - 44** Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. **45** Philip found Nathanael and said to him, “We have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.”

**46** And Nathanael said to him, “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?”

# NATE'S MOVEMENT

**John 1 - 46b** Philip said to him, "Come and see."

47 Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him, and said of him, "Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom is no deceit!"

48 Nathanael said to Him, "How do You know me?"

Jesus answered and said to him, "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you."

49 Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!"

# NATE'S LESSON

**John 1 - 50** Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe? You will see greater things than these." 51 And He said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, hereafter you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."

# CHOSEN PATHS

**John 11** - 45 Therefore many of the Jews who had come to visit Mary, and had seen what Jesus did, believed in him. 46 But some of them went to the Pharisees and told them what Jesus had done. 47 Then the chief priests and the Pharisees called a meeting of the Sanhedrin.

# INTIMIDATED ACTIONS

**John 11 - 47b** “What are we accomplishing?” they asked.

“Here is this man performing many signs. 48 If we let him go on like this, everyone will believe in him, and then the Romans will come and take away both our temple and our nation.”

49 Then one of them, named Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, spoke up, “You know nothing at all! 50 You do not realize that it is better for you that one man die for the people than that the whole nation perish.”

# RELIGION'S RESPONSE

John 11 - 51 He did not say this on his own, but as high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the Jewish nation, 52 and not only for that nation but also for the scattered children of God, to bring them together and make them one. 53 So from that day on they plotted to take his life.

# HOMETOWN JUDGEMENT

**Matthew 13 - 54** When He had come to His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, so that they were astonished and said, “Where did this Man get this wisdom and these mighty works? **55** Is this not the carpenter’s son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas? **56** And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this Man get all these things?” **57** So they were offended at Him.

# HOMETOWN VERDICT

**Mark 6 - 5** He could not do any miracles there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. **6**  
*He was amazed at their lack of faith.*

# HOMETOWN REACTIONS

**Luke 4 - 28** All the people in the synagogue were furious when they heard this. **29** They got up, drove him out of the town, and took him to the brow of the hill on which the town was built, in order to throw him off the cliff. **30** But he walked right through the crowd and went on his way.
