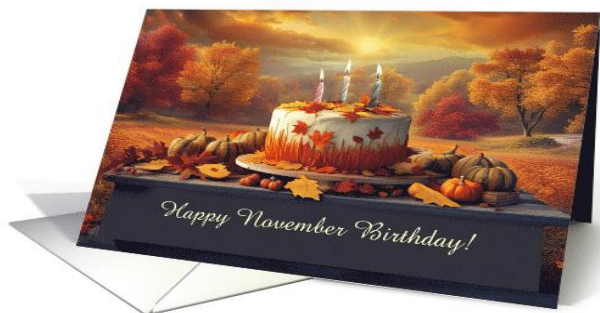
Heavenly Father,

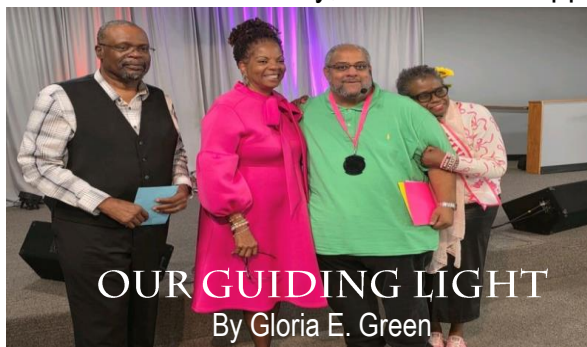
