Essential Question

Which scripture and theme stood out to you the most this week, and why?

☐ Overview of Week 2

Week 2 challenged us to move beyond just hearing the Word and into living it out. As women of God, we explored how scripture speaks directly to our everyday roles and responsibilities—as daughters, mothers, grandmothers, wives, leaders, mentors, caregivers, and servants.

This week reminded us that God's Word is not separate from our real lives—it is meant to shape how we show up in every hat we wear.

💡 Reflection Focus

Invite sisters to briefly share:

- One scripture that stood out
- One theme that challenged or encouraged them
- Why it connected to their current season

(This can be done popcorn-style or in pairs.)

👑 Key Themes That Often Rise in Week 2

- Endurance in trials
- Obedience over comfort
- Trusting God's process
- Faith lived out daily
- Spiritual maturity

☐ Key Points: Applying the Word to Our Roles & Hats

1. As Women with Many Roles

God's Word reminds us that we don't have to do everything perfectly—we are called to do things faithfully. Each role is a place where God can be glorified.

2. As Caregivers & Nurturers

Scripture helps us respond with grace instead of exhaustion, patience instead of frustration, and prayer instead of pressure.

3. As Leaders & Mentors

We are reminded that leadership begins with submission to God. How we live often speaks louder than what we say.

4. As Women Walking Through Trials

God uses difficulty to grow our endurance and deepen our trust. What feels heavy today may be producing strength for tomorrow.

Discussion Questions

Use 2–3 depending on time:

- Which scripture stayed with you this week, and what made it stand out?
- How did the theme of this week challenge how you see your current season?
- Which “hat” do you find most difficult to apply God’s Word to—and why?
- What is one practical way you can live out this scripture in the coming week?
- How can we, as sisters, help one another walk this out?
