

My Sisters Happy New Year!

In Lamentations 3:22–23, the phrase “new every morning” comes from the Hebrew word **ḥădāšîm** (חֲדָשִׁים), derived from **ḥădaš**, meaning fresh, renewed, restored, or repaired.
