WEEK 2 | Read John 1:29-42

²⁹ The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is the one I meant when I said, ‘A man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.’ ³¹ I myself did not know him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that he might be revealed to Israel.”

³² Then John gave this testimony: “I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. ³³ And I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, ‘The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.’ ³⁴ I have seen and I testify that this is God’s Chosen One.”

John’s Disciples Follow Jesus

³⁵ The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. ³⁶ When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, “Look, the Lamb of God!”

³⁷ When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, “What do you want?”

They said, “Rabbi” (which means “Teacher”), “where are you staying?”

³⁹ “Come,” he replied, “and you will see.”

So they went and saw where he was staying, and they spent that day with him. It was about four in the afternoon.

⁴⁰ Andrew, Simon Peter’s brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. ⁴¹ The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, “We have found the Messiah” (that is, the Christ). ⁴² And he brought him to Jesus.

Jesus looked at him and said, “You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas”

Jesus came to live among us and die for us to take away the guilty stain of our sins. This is great news! Just as the first disciples eagerly told others about Jesus, we should excited to share it with other people too.

Who is someone you would like to meet? Someone you would be super excited to see if they walked in the room?

I bet if that person was famous, you would be so excited and would want to tell your friends, right? Well, that happened when Jesus started His ministry here on earth. John the Baptist was one of the first people to realize who Jesus was and how important He was. John was so excited that he pointed Jesus out to others and told them they were looking at, “the Lamb of God”. They ran after Jesus, and when they

understood who He was they wanted to tell others about Him too. Meeting Jesus was something they didn't want to keep to themselves, they couldn't wait to tell others who they had found.

We should be just as excited to tell people the good news of Jesus. Knowing He died for us is amazing. The God that created the whole universe came to live as a person and gave up His life so that we could be adopted into His family and live as children of God!

That is so exciting! It should give us so much joy and hope that we should want to share it with everyone. We want others to know God's love and there are many ways we can do that. Of course, we can talk about it, but we can also share it with our actions. Doing kind things and letting people know we care about them.

We love you, God!



WEEK 3 | Matthew 16:13-20

¹³ When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do people say the Son of Man is?”

¹⁴ They replied, “Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.”

¹⁵ “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?”

¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.”

¹⁷ Jesus replied, “Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven. ¹⁸ And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.” ²⁰ Then he ordered his disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah.

Sometimes what we know and think about ourselves can be different than other people’s thoughts about who we are. Jesus was also someone whom people had all kinds of ideas and guesses about. In our Bible story today, people were saying Jesus was somebody great, like John the Baptist or one of the prophets. But what they didn’t understand was that Jesus was even greater than these men. He was more than a prophet or teacher, He was the Messiah that they all had been waiting for their whole lives!

When Peter said, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.” Jesus’ response was basically, “You are correct!” Jesus had been teaching the Disciples for three years little by little letting them know he was the One that God sent to save them.

But what about us? Do we know who He is? Jesus wasn’t just a neat person or a healer. He is the Savior. He came to save us and fulfilled God’s promises to us. Jesus is God’s Son. We should not keep that to ourselves, we should share it.

Pray:

Dear God,

Thank you for revealing yourself through Jesus. We know that HE is our Savior and Messiah.

Help us to remember that and share it with others.

Thank you for your love. We love you, God!



WEEK 4 | Read Matthew 28:16-20

¹⁶ Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. ¹⁷ When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. ¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

These Bible verses take place on Jesus' last day on earth before he rose to heaven. Jesus had told His disciples to meet Him in Galilee on a mountain. When they see Jesus they immediately worshiped Him. Jesus told them to "Go and make disciples of all nations..." Jesus is God's Son and he died for our sins so that we could be saved. Jesus wants us to go everywhere and tell everyone that message and he promises to always be with us.

We call Jesus' last words here on earth the Great Commission. It's a command or instruction on what to do. This instruction wasn't just for the disciples, it was for you and me. He wants us to go and tell everyone about Him.


