INTRODUCTION

In a world filled with distractions and a rapid pace of life, we need to carve out sacred moments where we can draw closer to God. We need to recognize the importance of strengthening the bonds within our families, understanding that prayer has the power to unite generations and instill shared values. We envision this prayer book as a tool to facilitate those intimate moments of reflection and devotion within our households. Additionally, we aim to foster a sense of unity within our church community, realizing that collective prayer has the potential to not only bring us closer to God but also to one another. This prayer book serves as a means to bring our church family together in faith, love, and solidarity on our journey of faith.

How to use this book

We want this year to be a year of growth for you and your family. Every month, there will be a specific topic for you and your family to discuss, pray over, and explore through reading scripture.

On each page, there are three different sections.

- 1. Basic truths can be memorized by younger children to help them build an understanding of the topic for the month.
- Discussion Questions can be used around the dinner table, car rides, or during your devotion time with your family.
- 3. Each day comes with a prayer prompt and scripture. Take some time to read the scripture and pray together as a family.

Basic Truth

Q: What is gratitude according to our faith?

A: Gratitude is thanking God for all the wonderful gifts He gives us, like our families, friends, and the beauty of the world.

- How do you think we can show gratitude towards God in our everyday actions and choices?
- Why is it important to say "thank you" to God for the blessings in our lives?
- What are some ways we can express our gratitude towards God as a family? (e.g., through prayers, songs, acts of kindness)

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Dear Lord, I thank You for the gift of life and all the blessings that come with it. Help me cultivate a heart of gratitude and recognize Your goodness in every aspect of my life."

Scripture: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." (Psalm 118:1)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I am grateful for the people You have placed in my life. Thank You for their love, support, and companionship. Help me cherish and appreciate them deeply."

Scripture: "I always thank my God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus." (1 Corinthians 1:4)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Gracious God, thank You for Your provision and sustenance. Help me be a good steward of the resources You have entrusted to me and use them to bless others."

Scripture: "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19)

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Loving Father, I am grateful for the gift of forgiveness and redemption through Jesus Christ. Thank You for extending Your mercy and grace to me despite my failures."

Scripture: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." (Psalm 107:1)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "Dear God, I am grateful for the opportunities You have provided for growth and learning. Thank You for guiding me and shaping me into the person You want me to be."

Scripture: "I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds." (Psalm 9:1)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I thank You for Your unfailing love and faithfulness. Help me remain steadfast in my devotion to You and share Your love with others."

Scripture: "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." (Psalm 136:1)

Basic Truth

Q: What is healing in our Christian faith? A: Healing, in our faith, is God's power to make us well-physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

- How can we pray for healing for ourselves and for others? What words or thoughts can we include in our prayers?
- How can we support and comfort someone who is going through a difficult time and needs healing, even if we can't physically heal them ourselves?
- What stories or verses from the Bible talk about healing through faith and prayer? (You can explore passages like Luke 8:43-48 or James 5:14-15.)



FEBRUARY

PRAYING FOR PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, AND SPIRITUAL HEALING FOR OURSELVES, OUR LOVED ONES, AND THOSE IN NEED.

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I come before You, seeking healing for myself and others who are in need. Please bring physical, emotional, and spiritual restoration to our lives."

Scripture: "Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise." (Jeremiah 17:14)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Lord Jesus, I pray for divine healing to flow through the hands of doctors, nurses, and healthcare professionals. Guide their treatments and bring comfort to those under their care." Scripture: "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones." (Proverbs 17:22)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Loving God, I lift up those who are burdened with emotional pain, trauma, or grief. Surround them with Your healing presence and grant them peace."

Scripture: "He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds." (Psalm 147:3)

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Merciful Father, I intercede for those struggling with addictions, destructive habits, or mental health challenges. Bring wholeness and deliverance to their lives."

Scripture: "He sent out his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave." (Psalm 107:20)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I ask for Your healing touch upon those facing chronic illnesses, debilitating conditions, or prolonged suffering. Grant them strength, comfort, and hope."

Scripture: "The Lord sustains them on their sickbed and restores them from their bed of illness." (Psalm 41:3)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Faithful God, I pray for spiritual healing and renewal in my own life and the lives of those around me. Revive our hearts, restore our faith, and draw us closer to You."

Scripture: "Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are my praise." (Jeremiah 17:14)



Basic Truth

Q: What is guidance in our Christian faith?

A: Guidance is when God shows us the way to go and helps us make good choices in our lives that glorify Him.

- What do you think it means to trust in God's plan and guidance, even when things don't go the way we expect?
- How can we recognize God's guidance in our lives? Are there signs or feelings that may indicate His leading?
- Can you think of any stories from the Bible where people sought God's guidance and received it? (You can explore stories like Moses and the burning bush in Exodus 3.)



GUIDANCE GUIDANCE: SEEKING GOD'S WISDOM AND GUIDANCE IN MAKING DECISIONS AND NAVIGATING LIFE'S CHALLENGES.

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I seek Your wisdom and guidance in every decision I make. Help me align my choices with Your perfect will and follow the path You have laid before me." Scripture: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Loving God, I surrender my plans and desires to You. Guide me in the way I should go and reveal Your purpose for my life. Open my eyes to see the opportunities You have prepared for me."

Scripture: "The Lord makes firm the steps of the one who delights in him." (Psalm 37:23)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Gracious Father, grant me discernment and clarity as I face challenges and seek solutions. Help me make wise decisions that honor You and benefit those around me." Basic Truth

Q: What is forgiveness in our Christian faith?

A: Forgiveness is when we choose to let go of hurt feelings and not be angry with someone who has done something wrong.

Family Discussion Questions

- Can you share a story from the Bible where forgiveness is a central theme, like the story of the Prodigal Son in Luke 15?
- How can we practice forgiveness in our daily lives, following God's example?
- Why is forgiveness important in our relationships with others and in our relationship with God?

FORGIVENESS

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Merciful Father, I come before You with a repentant heart, seeking Your forgiveness for my sins and shortcomings. Grant me the strength to turn away from my wrongdoings and walk in Your ways."

Scripture: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Lord Jesus, thank You for the gift of redemption and the forgiveness of sins through Your sacrifice. Help me truly grasp the depth of Your forgiveness and live in the freedom it brings."

Scripture: "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace." (Ephesians 1:7)

Thursday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, empower me to extend forgiveness to myself. Release me from guilt and self-condemnation, and help me embrace the grace You freely offer."

Scripture: "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." (Jeremiah 31:34)

Basic Truth

Family Discussion Questions

- How can we seek God's strength when we feel weak or afraid?
- What Bible stories or verses talk about finding strength in God? (You can explore stories like David and Goliath or verses like Philippians 4:13.)
- In what ways can we help others find strength when they're going through tough times?

- How can we promote peace in our relationships and communities, following the example of Jesus, who is often referred to as the Prince of Peace?

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Righteous God, I pray for justice to prevail in the world. Bring an end to oppression, inequality, and injustice. Empower us to stand up for the rights of the marginalized and advocate for a more just society."

Scripture: "Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow." (Isaiah 1:17)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Merciful Lord, open our eyes to see the injustices around us. Stir our hearts with compassion and ignite a passion for social justice. Guide us in taking action to bring about change."

Scripture: "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:8)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "God of righteousness, grant wisdom and discernment to those in positions of power and authority. May they govern with justice, integrity, and fairness, upholding the rights and dignity of all people."

Scripture: "When the righteous thrive, the people rejoice; when the wicked rule, the people groan." (Proverbs 29:2)

Thursday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, transform our hearts and minds to be agents of justice in our communities. Help us challenge systems of oppression and work towards equality and fairness for all."

Scripture: "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy." (Proverbs 31:8-9)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "God of righteousness, guide us in pursuing justice with love and compassion. Help us address systemic issues and promote lasting change that brings about a more just society."

Scripture: "Let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!" (Amos 5:24)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, grant us the courage to be advocates for justice in our daily lives. - Are there any Bible stories or verses that come to mind when you think about the importance of seeking wisdom from God? (Proverbs 2:6 or James 1:5)

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, grant me wisdom to make wise choices and discern Your will in all areas of my life. Help me seek Your guidance and follow Your path."

Scripture: "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you." (James 1:5)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Wise God, fill me with the knowledge and understanding that comes from You. Help me grow in wisdom and apply it to live a life that honors You." Scripture: "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding." (Proverbs 9:10)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, in moments of confusion and uncertainty, grant me clarity and insight. Illuminate my path with Your wisdom, that I may walk in righteousness and make decisions that align with Your truth."

Scripture: "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." (Psalm 119:105)

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Gracious God, help me seek wise counsel and surround myself with people who offer godly wisdom. Guide me in seeking advice and discerning the voices that align with Your truth."

Scripture: "Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm." (Proverbs 13:20)

WISDOM

Thursday Prayer Prompt: "Loving Father, teach me humility, for it is the foundation of wisdom. Help me approach life with a humble and teachable heart, ready to receive Your wisdom and correction."

Scripture: "Who is wise and understanding among you? Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom." (James 3:13)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "God of all knowledge, guide my thoughts and words, that they may be filled with wisdom and bring glory to Your name. May the wisdom I possess be a testimony of Your truth and grace."

Scripture: "The mouths of the righteous utter wisdom, and their tongues speak what is just." (Psalm 37:30)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I pray for wisdom to navigate the complexities of life. Help me see beyond the immediate and understand the eternal significance of my choices. May wisdom guide me in every aspect of my life."

Scripture: "Teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." (Psalm 90:12)

Basic Truth

Q: How can we thank God for His provision?

A: We can thank God for His provision by praying, being grateful, and sharing what we have with others. It shows our trust in His continued care.

- Can you think of things in your life that you're grateful to God for providing? (e.g., food, shelter, family)
- Are there any Bible stories or verses that come to mind when you think about God's role as a Provider? (You can explore passages like Matthew 6:25-34 or Psalm 23:1.)
- How can we practice gratitude for God's provision in our daily lives, and how can we share what we have with those in need?





OCTOBER

PROVISION

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Gracious Provider, I come before You with gratitude for Your abundant provision in my life. Thank You for meeting my needs and blessing me beyond measure."

Scripture: "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I surrender my worries and anxieties about my future and needs to You. Help me trust in Your faithful provision and rely on Your perfect timing."

Scripture: "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them." (Matthew 6:31-32)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Loving God, I seek Your provision not only for my material needs but also for my spiritual nourishment. Fill me with Your presence, wisdom, and grace, that I may be sustained and strengthened."

Scripture: "Jesus answered, 'It is written: "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.""

(Matthew 4:4)

PROVISION

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Provider of all things, I bring before You my financial concerns and burdens. Grant me wisdom in managing my resources, and bless the work of my hands that I may have an abundance to share with others."

Scripture: "Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously."

(2 Corinthians 9:6)

Thursday Prayer Prompt: "Generous God, teach me the joy of giving and sharing. Help me be a vessel of Your provision to bless others in need, that they may experience Your love and care."

Scripture: "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "Faithful Provider, I bring my dreams, goals, and aspirations to You. Guide me in using the resources You have given me to fulfill Your purposes and bring glory to Your name."

Scripture: "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans." (Proverbs 16:3)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I trust in Your unfailing provision even in times of scarcity or uncertainty. Strengthen my faith and help me rely on Your promises, knowing that You are my ultimate source of provision."

Scripture: "And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work." (2 Corinthians 9:8)

FAITHFULNESS

Basic Truth

Q: What is faithfulness in our Christian faith?

A: Faithfulness is being loyal and true to God, trusting Him always, and following His ways with love.

- Are there any Bible stories or verses that come to mind when you think about God's faithfulness? (You can explore passages like Lamentations 3:22-23 or Psalm 36:5.)
- How can we be faithful to God in our daily lives, and what are some ways we can trust Him even when we don't fully understand His plans?
- How can we pray for God's guidance and strength to remain faithful to Him and to the promises we make to others?



NOVEMBER

FAITHFULNESS

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, thank You for Your unwavering faithfulness throughout all generations. Help me grow in my trust and reliance on You, knowing that Your faithfulness endures forever."

Scripture: "Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments." (Deuteronomy 7:9)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Faithful God, strengthen my faith and deepen my devotion to You. Help me remain steadfast in times of trials and challenges, knowing that You are faithful to fulfill Your promises."

Scripture: "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful." (Hebrews 10:23)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, forgive me for the times I have faltered and doubted Your faithfulness. Renew my spirit and restore my confidence in Your steadfast love. Help me walk faithfully in Your ways."

Scripture: "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!"" (Matthew 25:23)

TRANSFORMATION

Basic Truth

Q: What is transformation in our Christian faith?

A: Transformation is when God helps us change and become more like Jesus, growing in love, kindness, and goodness.

- Are there any Bible stories or verses that come to mind when you think about God's power to bring about transformation? (You can explore passages like Romans 12:2 or 2 Corinthians 5:17.)
- How can we actively seek God's transformative work in our lives, and what role does prayer and studying His Word play in this process?
- How can we pray for God's guidance and grace in our journey of transformation, both individually and as a family?



TRANSFORMATION

Sunday Prayer Prompt: "Heavenly Father, I surrender myself to Your transforming power. Mold me into the person You created me to be. Transform my heart, mind, and character to reflect Your love and grace."

Scripture: "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and

this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is-his good, pleasing and perfect will." (Romans 12:2)

Monday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I pray for transformation in my thoughts and attitudes. Help me align my thinking with Your truth and replace negative thoughts with thoughts that are pure, noble, and praiseworthy."

Scripture: "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." (Philippians 4:8)

Tuesday Prayer Prompt: "Gracious God, transform my words and actions to reflect Your love and grace. Help me speak words of encouragement, kindness, and truth. May my actions bring hope, healing, and reconciliation."

Scripture: "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen." (Ephesians 4:29)

TRANSFORMATION

Wednesday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I pray for transformation in my relationships. Heal broken relationships, restore harmony, and deepen connections. Help me extend forgiveness, love, and grace as You have done for me." Scripture: "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity." (Colossians 3:13-14)

Thursday Prayer Prompt: "God of transformation, help me grow in my spiritual journey. Deepen my faith, increase my hunger for Your Word, and empower me to live a life that brings honor to Your name."

Scripture: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Friday Prayer Prompt: "Lord, I pray for transformation in my actions and habits. Help me break free from patterns of sin and live a life that reflects Your righteousness. Empower me to walk in obedience to Your commands."

Scripture: "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God-this is your true and proper worship." (Romans 12:1)

Saturday Prayer Prompt: "Loving God, I pray for transformation in the world around me. Use me as an instrument of Your love and grace to bring about positive change. May Your transformative power be evident in society."

Scripture: "Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:16)
