

## DAILY DEVOTIONS – FAITH

Use this devotional to reinforce the study you've taken part in. As you read the following passages ask God to meet with you. Read the passage. Reflect on what it says and what God could be saying through it. Finally, respond to what you've read. We encourage you to write down some of the things that God speaks to you about.

### MONDAY – FAITH BEGINS WITH GOD

#### READ

Hebrews 12:1-2

#### REFLECT

Faith doesn't originate from us; it begins and ends with God. We often feel the pressure to perform. True faith reminds us that following Jesus starts with dependence. God calls us to follow from trust, not control.

#### RESPOND

Spend time today surrendering any area where you've been relying on yourself instead of God.

### TUESDAY – FAITH OVER FEELINGS

#### READ

Hebrews 11:1

#### REFLECT

Faith is choosing to believe God even when you don't feel it or see it. Life often takes us through uncertain seasons. That's when faith becomes most powerful, when we act on trust rather than emotion.

#### RESPOND

Reflect on a recent decision you made based on faith. What did you learn about God's faithfulness?

### WEDNESDAY – FAITH THAT HEARS

#### READ

Romans 10:17

#### REFLECT

Faith grows as we listen to God's Word. Spiritual formation depends on how well we hear His voice. The more we fill our hearts with His truth, the stronger our faith becomes.

#### RESPOND

Set aside time today to read or listen to Scripture without distractions. Ask God to speak clearly to your heart about your walk with Him.

### THURSDAY – FAITH THAT ACTS

#### READ

James 2:17

#### REFLECT

Faith isn't passive, it's hope in action. It's choosing to obey God even when the path isn't clear. A life shaped by faith moves forward in obedience, trusting God to provide along the way.

#### RESPOND

What step of obedience is God asking you to take right now? Write it down and act on it this week.

## DAILY DEVOTIONS – MORAL EXCELLENCE

### FRIDAY – DECISION-MAKING WITH EXCELLENCE

#### READ

Colossians 3:17

#### REFLECT

A helpful question before making any decision is, “Will this be pleasing to God?” Moral excellence shapes our decisions and actions, ensuring they reflect God’s character and honor Him.

#### RESPOND

How can you apply the question, “Will this be pleasing to God?” in your decisions today?

### SATURDAY – STANDING OUT IN A WORLD OF COMPROMISE

#### READ

Matthew 5:16

#### REFLECT

Followers of Jesus live differently from the world, demonstrating moral excellence through visible choices and actions. Our lives should draw attention not to ourselves, but to God’s heart and character.

#### RESPOND

What is one specific action you can take this week to visibly reflect God’s holiness in your life?

### SUNDAY – THE INFLUENCE OF MORAL EXCELLENCE

#### READ

Titus 2:7-8

#### REFLECT

Pursuing moral excellence not only refines our own lives but also influences others. When we live with integrity and character, people are drawn to God’s hope, healing, peace, and purpose through us.

#### RESPOND

How can your pursuit of moral excellence inspire and influence those around you this week?
