LEADERSHIP SELECTION

"Here is a trustworthy saying: whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task." -1 Timothy 3:1

1 Timothy 3:1 – 7 and Titus 1:5 – 9 have a list of attributes for mature men who seek to be an elder. We encourage our congregation to read through the attributes and encourage those they believe are spiritually mature to fill out a "desire to serve card" through the month of August.

The process begins with the individual's heart. A man who desires to serve as an elder submits a desire to serve card. The cards are then reviewed and contact is made by the current eldership. After a time of evaluation, a list of proposed elders to serve a three-year term will be posted in October. The list of men is presented to the congregation for affirmation in November. The men affirmed will be ordained as elders and will begin to serve in January.

I would ask that you would pray as we go through this process of selecting leadership. I believe it is imperative for us to be in prayer and to ask God to lead and to raise up leaders who will follow Him. I know for a fact all of our leaders covet your prayers and encouragements as they strive to be the best leaders they can be for FCC.



PRAYING FOR YOUR STUDENT

MISSION SPOTLIGHT

August is back-to-school time! We have many missions on our list that support schools and students. Did you know **Faith Promise** and **Golden Bowl** support ministries for local students? Our area elementary schools have students without reliable food. First Christian Church coordinates "backpacks" to send food into those homes during the weekend.

We are also involved at the following college campuses:

Christian Campus House at Eastern Illinois University, Ozark Christian College, Central Christian College of the Bible, and Johnson University.

Matthew Thomas, Campus Minister with Christian Campus House (CCH) at EIU, Charleston, IL came to update us on the ministry. Matthew assumed the role of Campus Minister following the retirement of Roger Songer in 2016. He received his Master's degree in Christian Ministry from Lincoln Christian University, while serving as an Associate Minister of CCH, and has been preaching, teaching, and discipling for over 20 years with CCH.



CCH's attendance is around 50 – 60 students each Sunday morning with about 50 on Wednesday nights. Services there are similar to a traditional church service. Many of the students who attend never attended church regularly. During the first two weeks each semester there are special activities every night. Mission trips are offered and students commonly elect to do short-term work at ministries like Shiloh Christian Children's Home. Former students have accepted a calling into full-time ministry through the discipleship and God's leading from EIU's Christian Campus House. Matthew thanked First Christian Church for its continued support and invites us to visit them.

Pray for our students and the campuses near and far that God's light will be evident, leading people to Him.

While in Poland, our mission team experienced God's work in the lives at **Save A Life ministry**. The team heard from the women first-hand their moving testimonies and toured the facility. With the generous giving for 2025 Faith Promise, First Christian Church will be sending \$5,000 to meet needs of Save a Life in Poland, through Polish Christian Ministries.
