
GOD ANSWERS PRAYER REQUESTS THREE WAYS... YES, NO, or WAIT

Take the Family Challenge

Say "Thank You!" to God as a family! Here are a few ideas:

- Write many things you are thankful for on little slips of paper and put them in a jar. Pull one out each day and pray together, thanking God for that thing.
- Create a "Thankfulness Chain" using colorful paper cut into strips. Write one thing you're thankful for on each strip of paper, then create a chain by stapling or taping the strips of paper into rings around each other.
- Create a poster that says "Thank You, God!" and put it on your door. Each time you leave your home, stop and quickly pray before you open the door, focusing on thanking God.
- Pick a worship song that is about thanking God and sing it together as a family.


