John the Baptist confidently served God as he announced Jesus' coming! He is a great example of someone who was confident while serving God. Here are some ways you can be a confident Christian:

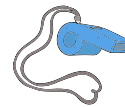
- Tell others about the Gospel, using the Wordless Book
