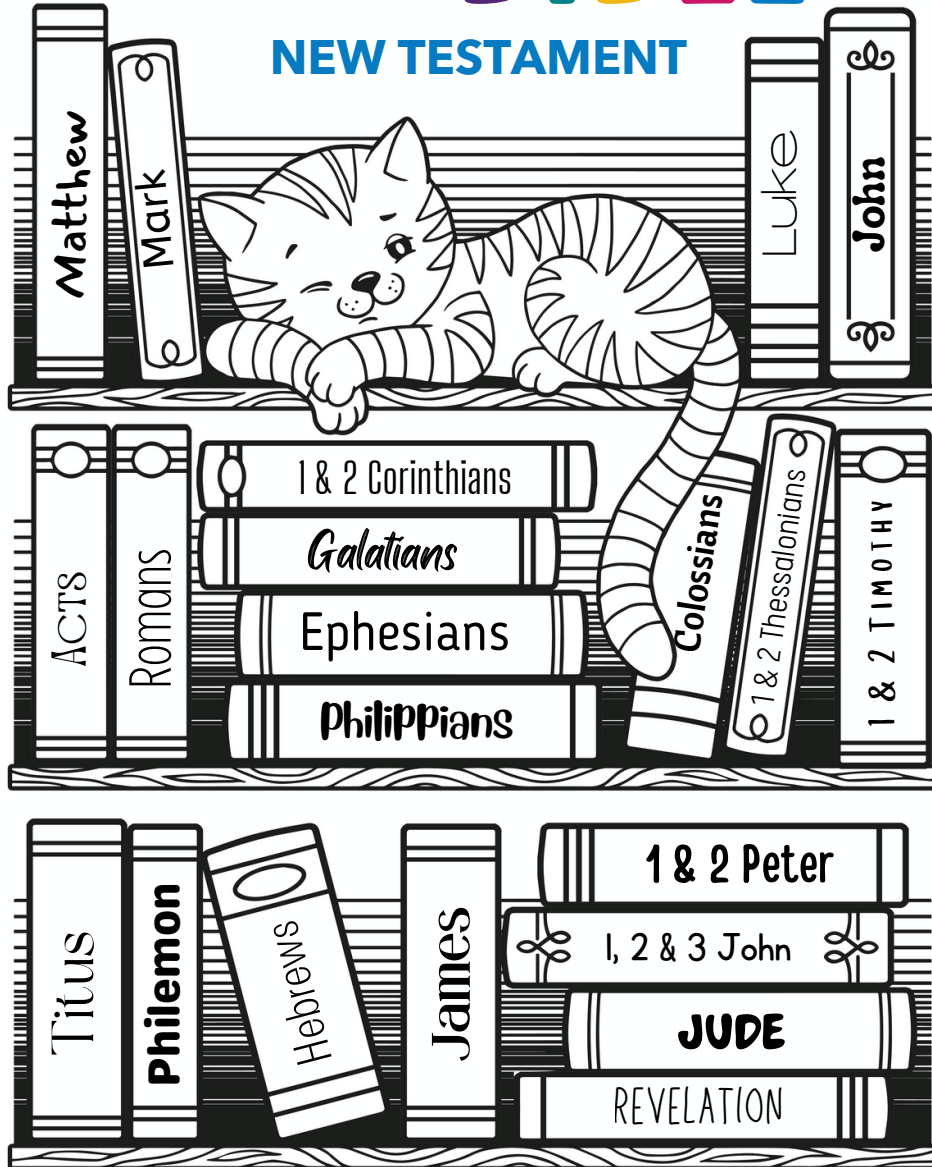


Parents, review the books of the New Testament with your child and then have them color the books.

**Elijah and Elisha see
God's power.**

1 Kings 19:19-21;
2 Kings 2:1-18

Hey parents!

Throughout the Bible we see God's great power on display. Is that power still visible today? Yes! We can see God's power in nature, in His answers to prayer, and in how the Holy Spirit equips us for faithful obedience each day. This week, make an extra effort to pay attention to where God's power might be on display. When you see God at work, point it out to your kids, so they can marvel at God's majesty with you!

KNOW RIGHT

Elijah and Elisha see God's power.

THINK RIGHT John 3:16 (Top 12)

"For God (point up) **so loved** (hands over heart) **the world** (hands circled above head) **that He gave His one** (pointer finger) **and only Son** (point to the palm of each hand), **that whoever believes** (point to head) **in Him** (point up) **shall not perish** (shake finger and head) **but have eternal life** (thumbs up)." **John 3:16**



Gather a ball and a basket and play a game with your child, trying to toss the ball into the basket. Every time you or your child makes a basket, recite John 3:16 with the actions.

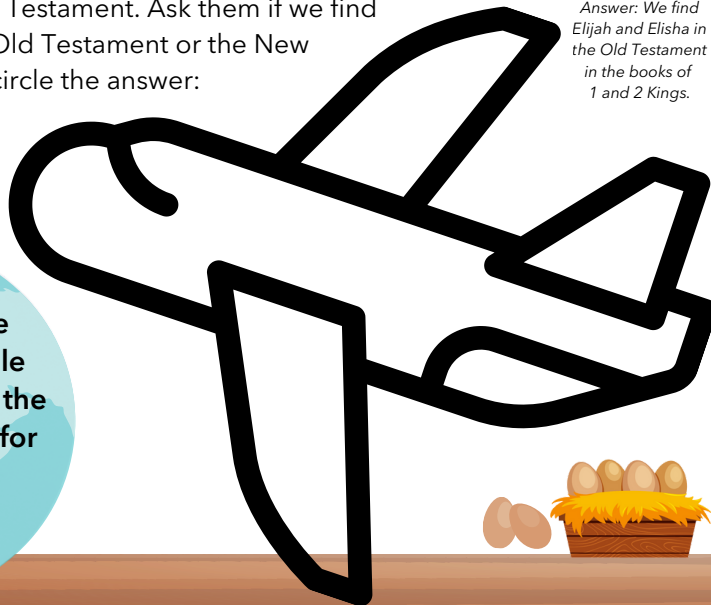
GET ON TRACK!
