

Job Description for Associate Pastor of Students

Personal Attributes

Primary Responsibilities

- Oversee Sunday morning Children's Church- currently Preschool-2nd grade (approximately 35 minutes during the 11am worship service after the Congregational singing, excluding some services such as The Lord's Supper,)
- Oversee the Wednesday night Student Services ensuring adequate time is spent in study of God's Word
- Participate with other parachurch ministries (for example, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and the Banks County Christian Learning Center)
- Routinely support and/or attend other ministries at the church
- Be involved with missions and lead students in doing so as well
- Plan, coordinate, and carry-out with the assistance of other Adult Volunteers various trips throughout the church year
- Provide general oversight to student volunteers
- Work with various teams throughout the church to promote spiritual growth within the students
- Perform other pastoral responsibilities assigned by the Senior Pastor (such responsibilities could include but not limited to preaching, visiting, funerals, & weddings)
- The Associate Pastor of Students and the Discipleship Pastor will work in tandem to develop and oversee a comprehensive gospel-centered discipleship strategy for students
- The Associate Pastor of Students will be directly accountable to the Senior Pastor
