# SILENT AUCTION

## REGISTRATION

- All bidders must register at the admission table.
- All bidders must be at least 18 years of age.

## AUCTION IS OPEN

- During the silent auction, bids are submitted by writing your bid on the designated bid sheet along with your assigned bidding number.
- Bid sheets may indicate a starting or minimum bid.
- Bids must be increased in full dollar amounts.
- Each basket will have a unique number assigned to it and referenced on the corresponding Bid Sheet
  - Sheets shall be next to or in front of each item
  - VERIFY the descriptions on the bid sheet.
  - Verify that you are entering a bid on the intended item.
- If a bid sheet is full, please notify an Auction Official.
  - A new bid sheet will be provided.

## AUCTION CLOSING

- The auction will close in sections just before 8PM.
- The highest listed bidder (at the time that the bid sheets are collected) is the winner of the item.
- All accounting is done during Game #3.
  - *We appreciate your patience as we complete this task.*
  - Payments will be accepted only after all bid sheets have been tallied and winners have been verified.

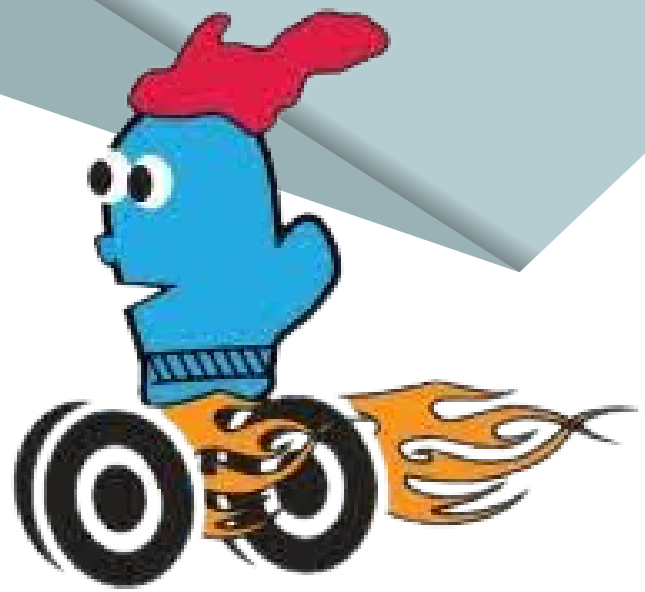
