

Half-Day Kindergarten Program

Our Kindergarten class meets Monday through Friday and is limited to a maximum of 14 students, ensuring individualized attention. Each classroom is staffed by both a Lead Teacher and an Assistant Teacher. **Children must be at least 5 years old by Sept. 1 to participate in our Kindergarten program.** Each day, children bring a snack, lunch, and water bottle from home.

Our Kindergarten program is fully accredited by Christian Schools of Florida and registered with the State of Florida, making students eligible for 1st grade upon successful completion of the program.

Families receive:

- Quarterly report cards
- Parent-Teacher conferences held in both the fall and spring

Curriculum & Instruction

We use Envision Math and Open Court Reading as core curriculum programs, while also integrating STEAM activities throughout the school year. Our program emphasizes hands-on, play-based learning to support academic growth, creativity, and social development.

Students also participate in weekly Chapel.

Qualified Teachers

Our Kindergarten teachers are Certified or hold a Bachelor's degree in Education and have successfully passed Level 2 background screenings through the ACHA Clearinghouse.

Scholarships

Kindergarten families may be eligible for Florida's School Choice Scholarships, which can cover the majority of annual tuition.
