

Three's Program

Children enrolled in our Three's Program must be 3 years old by September 1 and independent in the bathroom. We offer both 2-day and 3-day class options. Each day, children bring a snack, lunch, and water bottles from home. We have a maximum of 12 children in each class, led by a Lead Teacher and Assistant Teacher.

Our Three's classes focus on the development of social and emotional skills. Through daily activities, children are learning how to share, take turns, express feelings, and build relationships with their peers.

In our Three's classrooms, children participate in circle time, where they listen to stories, sing and dance, and play games with their classmates. During Center Time, children explore a variety of learning areas, including building with blocks, painting at the easel, relaxing in the reading corner, playing dress up, caring for baby dolls, and cooking in housekeeping. Children also have outdoor play on the playground.

Children also attend weekly Chapel, where our Children's Ministry Director engages them through age-appropriate lessons and activities.

Before eating, children wash their hands and pray together with their friends at the table. This routine helps build healthy habits while fostering gratitude and a sense of community.
