



FOREFRONT SMALL GROUP STUDY

Circles > Rows is a short series that explores how the Gospel doesn't just gather us for worship—it shapes us through community. While Sunday services matter, real transformation happens when we move from sitting in rows to living life in circles. Through Scripture and shared stories, this series invites us to step out of isolation, discover new perspectives of Jesus through one another, and experience the kind of belonging we were designed for.

Icebreaker Question:

If you could instantly become an expert in one skill (no practice required), what would you choose—and what would you do with it?

DAILY WALK / NEXT STEP:

The “One Text” Challenge:

Pray for 30 seconds, then send one message to one person this week:

“Hey, you’ve been on my mind. How can I pray for you this week?”

Then follow up and actually pray for them (even if it’s short).

That’s how circles start. That’s how stories multiply.

GROUP STUDY:

Acts 1:8; Matthew 28:19–20; 2

Timothy 2:2

1. When you hear the word “discipleship,” what comes to mind? What excites you about it, and what feels intimidating?
 2. Who has played a meaningful role in your faith journey (or personal growth journey)? What did they do that impacted you?
 3. Why do you think people sometimes stop at belonging and never move into multiplying?
 4. What does it look like to “invest in someone” in a way that feels natural and not forced or awkward?
 5. If you could describe your current season in one phrase—growing, stuck, rebuilding, thriving, tired, curious, etc.—why that phrase?
 6. What’s one simple step you could take to help someone feel seen, supported, or spiritually encouraged this week?
 7. What would change in your life if you believed: “My story is meant to become hope for someone else”?
