What if the biggest threat to our faith isn't unbelief... but living like God doesn't matter?

Practical Atheism explores the gap between what we say we believe and how we actually live. This series challenges us to move beyond agreeing with truth on Sunday to being transformed by it Monday through Saturday—inviting us from knowing about Jesus to truly knowing Him.

Icebreaker Question: If you could instantly master one skill that would benefit others around you, what would it be and why?

DAILY WALK / NEXT STEP:

Practice being a conduit.

Ask God each morning: “Who can I love today?”

Then act on the first simple opportunity — a text, encouragement, forgiveness, or act of service.

Small obedience trains our hearts to live from love instead of effort.
