Series Overview: But God

When life feels finished, God is still writing the story. **Read: Esther 4:12-16 Esther 9:1
Proverbs 21:1**

1. Have you ever had a moment where you felt like you were in the right place at the right time? What made it stand out?
2. Why do you think it's so hard to trust God when we don't have clarity on the outcome?
3. Where in your life do you currently feel like you're “waiting”? How might that actually be a place of purpose?
4. Esther had to act without certainty. What's an area in your life where you feel God nudging you to act anyway?
5. How have you seen God work “behind the scenes” in your life—either in the moment or looking back later?
6. What does obedience look like in a practical sense for you this week?
7. How can we encourage each other to take steps of faith when fear is present?
