Read: 2 Kings 6:8–23

1. Have you ever been in a situation where you later realized there was much more happening than you understood at the time?
2. Why do you think fear so often fills in the gaps when we don't know the whole story?
3. When life feels overwhelming, what helps you remember God's presence instead of only focusing on the problem?
4. Can you think of a time when your perspective changed before your circumstances did? What happened?
5. The message said, "Don't write the ending before the Author is finished telling the story." Why is that so difficult for us?
6. How does Jesus' death and resurrection remind us that God is often doing His greatest work when it looks like hope is gone?
7. If you truly believed this week that "the hills were never empty," how might your decisions, prayers, or attitude change?
