DAILY WALK / NEXT STEP:

Remember Before You Worry
When anxiety, uncertainty, or disappointment makes you ask, "God, how can I know?" pause before trying to solve it.

Take five minutes to write down three ways God has already been faithful in your life—or three promises from Scripture that reveal His character. Let what you remember shape how you face what is still uncertain.

Read: Genesis 15:1–21

1. Have you ever made a promise that became harder to keep than you expected? What made it difficult?
2. Abram asked, "How can I know?" What questions about God or faith do people commonly wrestle with today?
3. Why do we often trust our circumstances more than God's character?
4. Think of a season when you waited longer than you wanted. What did it teach you about trust or patience?
5. How does the idea that God's plans may extend beyond our timelines challenge our culture's view of success, progress, or answered prayer?
6. Genesis 15 points to Jesus carrying what we never could. How does that shape the way you understand grace, obedience, or relationship with God?
7. What promise of God do you need to hold onto this week, and why?
