2. What good things can become sources of confidence rather than gifts from God?
3. Why did God address the idol in Gideon's home before Israel's enemy?
4. Why is it easier to ask God to change our circumstances than our hearts?
5. Why did God reduce Gideon's army? What did He want Israel to learn?
6. How does the cross help us trust God when defeat seems more visible than victory?
7. Where does life feel smaller right now? What would trusting God there look like?
