



Sunday School – COVID 19 Policy & Procedures

Face Coverings:

All attendees, children (age 5 and up), staff, and volunteers present in the church building are required to wear a face covering, in accordance with the State of Minnesota Mask Mandate.

Before Coming to Church:

Prior to attending, families will be asked to screen their child at home for symptoms of illness and keep them home from church if they have symptoms or have been exposed to someone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.

In the Classroom:

Tables, chairs and toys will be sanitized at the end of Sunday School, and more often as feasible.

In the Hallways, Bathroom and Common Areas:

Physical distancing will be maintained as much as possible while children are moving throughout the building. We ask that children use the bathroom immediately before attending Sunday School. We ask that your children use sanitizer when entering the classroom or Youth Center.

Entering and Exiting the Church and Children's Wing:

We ask that upon your arrival to our campus, parents and children will utilize Door #2 (South Foyer) when entering the church. Please social distance from the family in front of you, and pick up your children's stickers at the Check-In Station. We ask that only one parent pick up or drop off your children to limit the number of people in the Children's Wing and South Foyer.

What is the plan if there's a positive case in my child's class?:

If a child or volunteer tests positive for COVID-19 that has been in attendance, Lakes Free Church leadership will recommend the next steps for the church and for any close contacts of the person who tested positive. We will notify parents of any known positive cases as soon as possible.
