

- P: People of God, do you promise to support Graysyn William and pray for him in his new life in Christ?
- C: We do.
- P: I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church. Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God?
- C: I renounce them.
- P: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God?
- C: I renounce them.
- P: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God?
- C: I renounce them.
- P: Do you believe in God the Father?
- C: I believe in God, the Father almighty creator of heaven and earth.
- P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?
