We tried to be adaptive in this time to ensure that we could meet the needs of our church members and fulfill our mission in the community in new ways.

We put in a brand new live-stream system to allow us to offer hybrid inperson and online worship.

We found ways to love one another virtually through Zoom Bible Studies and in-person through dinners, breakfasts, and pot-lucks later in the year.

Our Future Plans

In 2022, our ministry plan includes the following increases:

- A 5% raise for our lay staff and a 7% raise for our pastor in recognition of their hard work during the pandemic
- Increased Connectional Apportionment giving
- A \$600/month principal payment on our mortgage in order to reduce our debt more quickly (had been budgeted but not paid during the pandemic)
 However, over the past year, general fund giving has steadily declined. In order to accomplish all we have set out to do without dipping greatly into our reserves,
