By wisdom a house is built, and by understanding it is established; by knowledge the rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches.



FAITH AT HOME GAME PLAN

According to **Hebrews 10:25** the importance of a healthy local church can only increase with the passing of time. Therefore, a healthy Christian is one who remains connected to church life throughout the week. **Obedience** in this regard is one key to the health of any local church. So, in addition to one's personal Bible reading and prayer we'd like to suggest some basic ways to bring church life more in tune with home life. If this concept is new to you, start with consistency in one area and develop the others in time.

- 1. Review the Sermon: Life Notes are provided to help you revisit the sermon text. Plan family time to discuss the sermon at some point in the week and/or attend a Life Group to discuss the sermon with others. For Life Group information call one of the pastors.
- 2. <u>Learn the Memory verse</u>: Encourage everyone to learn the verse. Families with young children might decide to commit one night during the week to learn the verse together. For creative verse learning ideas visit: https://bethlehem.church/memory-verse-games/ Search for an opportunity to share the verse with someone else this week.
- 3. <u>Family Prayer</u>: Determine a plan for praying through the church and missionary prayer lists. Throughout the week and especially on Sunday, ask others how you can pray for them and add those requests to pg. 3. Encourage teens and children to adopt this practice and do the same. Family meal times might be ideal for this.
- 4. <u>Build the body</u>: Find a way to connect with at least one other person in the church. It can be as simple as a text message or phone call to let someone know you prayed for them, or it could be getting together with someone for games or a meal. Encourage children and teens to pray for their church friends and reach out to them as well.
- 5. <u>Prepare for worship</u>: On Saturday evening, take a few minutes to read the upcoming sermon text. Take time to confess sin and express gratitude to God for his blessings. Ask God's blessing on Sunday services, salvation for the lost, hospitality toward our guests, and sensitivity to the needs of others, etc.


