But God never left my side. He loved me even when I did not love myself. I gave birth to my daughter in 2016 and believed she was the one thing that I always wanted that would fulfill me, that would save me. I was very wrong! Only God could fill the massive hole I felt in my heart. I turned back to drugs after I ran from any responsibility that somehow made me feel helpless. He says YOU ARE worth it! He says YOU ARE special! He says with Him, you can crawl out of the darkness and into His marvelous light. I want to thank Him for restoring my family, my heart and my mind!
