The Word states in Isaiah 64:8 - 'But now, O Lord, You are our Father; We are the clay, and You our potter; And all we are the work of Your hand.' Isaiah 64:8

So, with the touch of the potter's hands, a piece of clay can become a great vessel. The work of the potter is done through His hands. When a potter is working he has to put one hand inside the vessel for support as He puts pressure on the outside.

MISSION STORIES The Testimony of Thomas Bond



God will never give you more than you can handle...right? I used to believe this statement to be true, until one day I found myself hopeless and without purpose. What started out as innocent fun on the weekends, eventually turned into a 14-year alcohol and methamphetamine addiction. My name is Thomas Bond and here is a little of my story...

I am the youngest of three and was raised by my mom and one older sister. Growing up without a father figure had a tremendous impact on me. I always felt that there was something missing in life. There was an empty feeling inside of me, a void that longed to be filled. Life was everything but normal. It was often abusive in my home and because of this, I took advantage of every opportunity that got me out of the house, including going to church. I professed to be a Christian, but nothing changed in my life.

By the time I got into high school, I found myself without direction. I couldn't really tell you what made me happy or what I even wanted to be when I grew up. To add to this meaningless life that I was living, I experienced a very devastating event my senior year. I found my cousin dead due to an overdose. Within the next two years, I found myself in self-pity and battling with depression. I began to mask the pain with copious amounts of alcohol. Shortly after, some other unfortunate events came about which eventually led to my meth addiction over the next few years. I just couldn't understand why life was constantly going in a downward spiral. Rather than trying a different approach when life got tough, I added more alcohol or more drugs to help numb the heartache. I began searching for anything that would fill the void inside my heart. Things worked for a short time, but the emptiness always came back, and my desperation grew.

Something had to give. My way just wasn't working. I had tried it for far too long and I finally hit rock bottom. I was tired and didn't feel the need to live any longer. BUT GOD! I reached out to my aunts for help and six months later I was drawn to Mission of Hope. The fact that it was a faith-based program kept drawing my attention. I didn't exactly know what that meant, but I knew it must be a God thing, so I figured I'd give it a try. On September 23, 2019, I came into the 3month program. The love and compassion that each staff member has expressed since day one is indescribable. They didn't exactly know my story, and to be honest, they didn't care! They just loved on me anyway.

Upon completion of the 3-month program, I was accepted into the 12-month "Step-Up" program. This program is a discipleship program designed to help you grow spiritually deeper. I am beyond thankful for the opportunity that the Mission has given me and for God's grace throughout this journey. It has been such a blessing to be a part of this ministry. I graduate from the "Step-Up" program on January 14th and hope to become part of the staff if it be His plan!

The Mission of Hope has taught me that to know God on a deep, intimate level, you must obtain a relationship with Him.
