What does it take for any of us to be truly in a right relationship with God? The answer is the same whether we are at the Mission of Hope rehabilitating or sitting at church every Sunday seeking to follow God.

Consider Ezra 10:1-2. Now while Ezra was praying and making confession, weeping and prostrating himself before the house of God, a very large assembly, men, women and children, gathered to him from Israel; for the people wept bitterly. When is the last time you wept as you made confession to God for your sins? Have you let sin become so common and grace become casual that your sins are not grievous? The ministering leader, Ezra was grieved and then it says a very large assembly of men, women and children gathered and wept bitterly. What was happening just before this moment is the priest was sacrificing a lamb for the sins of the nation.

I wonder at times if we saw an innocent lamb dragged down the aisles of our nice clean churches and a knife put to his throat to drain his blood for our sins into a bowl to offer at the Mercy Seat, if our hearts would soften a bit. Would we actually care about the innocent animal that had to die for us? Jesus is the LAMB of GOD and while 100% man he was also 100% God. He, Jesus, your Savior, holy and innocent and pure was paraded down the streets of Jerusalem, mocked, humiliated and hung naked on a cross to die for your sins. Does it move you to confess known sin to a HOLY, INNOCENT GOD who gave His son for your sins? Have we lost the ability to hurt for Christ? Can you weep over the depth and depravity you have in your own heart? I believe many of us need to ask God to soften the callouses that are on our hearts and allow us to connect again with the pain we should feel for our sins. 
