THREE POWERFUL TRUTHS **ABOUT GOD’S WORKINGS IN** **OUR LIVES**

- 1. God Works in the Silence –
TRUST HIM.**

Psalm 46:10 “Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!”

***The Hebrew word for
WILDERNESS OR DESERT is
“Midbar”, the root word is
“Dabar” meaning, “TO SPEAK.”***

1 Kings 19:11-13 “Go out, and stand on the mountain before the Lord.’ And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind tore into the mountains and broke the rocks in pieces before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind; and after the

wind an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice.”

**Don't mistake silence for
absence. God is working in
the quiet.**

Habakkuk 2:20 “But the Lord is in His holy temple. Let all the earth keep silence before Him.”

**Quietness carries a power louder
than words.**

2. God Works Through Our Pain – HOLD ON.

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 “And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. Concerning this thing, I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ

may rest upon me...for Christ's sake.
For when I am weak, then I am
strong.”

**The irritations of life are God's
raw material for pearls
of virtue.**

2 Corinthians 4:17 “For our light
affliction, which is but for a moment,
is working for us a far more exceeding
and eternal weight of glory.”

James 1:2-4 “My brethren, count it all
joy when you fall into various trials,
knowing that the testing of your faith
produces patience. But let patience

have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.”

Pain is not your end; it is the beginning of your becoming.

2 Corinthians 4:8-9 “We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed.”

Romans 5:3-4 “And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation

produces perseverance; and
perseverance, character; and
character, hope.”

Isaiah 41:10 “Fear not, for I am with
you; Be not dismayed, for I am your
God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will
help you, I will uphold you with My
righteous right hand.”

3. God Works for Our Good – STAY FAITHFUL.

Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the
thoughts that I think toward you,’ says

the Lord, ‘thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.’”

Genesis 50:20 “But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good...”

Romans 8:28 “And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.”
