**THREE BLESSINGS IN DESTINY
SHAPING PRAYERS**

1. INFLUENCE.

“Enlarge my territory”

Matthew 5:13,16 “You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. Let

your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.”

Destiny is not just about personal fulfillment—it’s about impact.

Isaiah 54:2-3 “Enlarge the place of your tent, And let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; Do not spare; Lengthen your cords, And strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, And your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited.”

Psalm 18:19 “He also brought me out into a broad place; He delivered me because He delighted in me.”

**Destiny Prayer shatters
boundaries and expands grace.**

Daniel 12:3 “Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.”

**Destiny shifts when prayer
moves from “God doing for us”
to “God doing through us”.**

2. PRESENCE

***“That Your hand would be with
me”***

Luke 12:16-21 “Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: ‘The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. And he thought within himself, saying, ‘What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?’ So he said, ‘I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there

I will store all my crops and my goods.
And I will say to my soul, ‘Soul, you
have many goods laid up for many
years; take your ease; eat, drink, and
be merry.’ But God said to him, ‘Fool!
This night your soul will be required of
you; then whose will those things be
which you have provided?’ So is he
who lays up treasure for himself, and
is not rich toward God.”

**The richest blessings are
wrapped in gifts and rooted in
presence.**

Ecclesiastes 6:2 “A man to whom God has given riches and wealth and honor, so that he lacks nothing for himself of all he desires; yet God does not give him power to eat of it, but a foreigner consumes it. This is vanity, and it is an evil affliction.”

**Only in His presence do I find the
grace to truly enjoy His gifts.**

Proverbs 10:22 “The blessing of the Lord makes one rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.”

Psalm 73:24 “You guide me with Your counsel, leading me to a glorious destiny.”

3. PRESERVATION

“That You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!”

Genesis 12:2 “I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing.”

Psalm 67:7 “God shall bless us, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him.”

Numbers 6:24 “The Lord bless you
and keep you...”
