1. THE RIGHT OBJECTIVE.

“But SEEK...”

🔑 **Priority insight:** Whatever you *seek* is what organizes your decisions, time, and emotional energy.

*“...the Kingdom of God and His
Righteousness”*

**The Kingdom of God is the realm
in which God’s reign is
experienced.**

Luke 17: 20-21 “Once, on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, Jesus replied, ‘The coming of the kingdom of God is not something that can be observed, nor will people say, ‘Here it is,’ or ‘There it is,’ because the kingdom of God is in your midst.’”

2. THE RIGHT ORDER.

“But seek FIRST...”

God’s Place is FIRST.

Colossian 1:15-18 “He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. For by Him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities - all things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. And He is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning,

the firstborn from the dead, that in everything He might be preeminent”

🔑 **Priority insight: Kingdom-first doesn’t mean God gets a time slot. It means God gets the *throne*.**

Reordered Kingdom Priorities

From livelihood → lordship (Matthew 4:18–22)

From family duty → eternal allegiance (Luke 9:59–62)

From religious activity → relational devotion (Luke 10:38–42)


From wealth → surrender (Mark
10:17–22)

From self-preservation → self-denial
(Matthew 16:24–26)

3. THE RIGHT OUTCOME.

“All these things shall be added...”

**Provision is promised, but it is
never meant to be prioritized.**

 **Priority insight: Stop chasing
things that were meant to be
added.**

Matthew 6:32 “Your Father Knows that you need them.”

**Right Objective → Right Order →
Right Outcome = Destiny
Priorities.**

Revelation 11:15 “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Messiah, and He will reign for ever and ever.”
