Psalm 73:24-28 “You guide me with Your counsel, leading me to a glorious destiny. Whom have I in heaven but You? I desire You more than anything on earth. My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the strength of my heart; He is mine forever. I have made the Sovereign Lord my shelter, and I will tell everyone about the wonderful things You do.”

Three Steps to Achieve Your Glorious Destiny

1. Envision the Great Potential of Your Glorious Destiny.

Psalm 73:24 “You guide me with Your counsel, leading me to a glorious destiny.”

Ephesians 2:10 “For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago.”

Psalm 139:13-14 “For You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother’s womb. I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.”

Matthew 18:3 “I tell you the truth, unless you turn from your sins and become like little children, you will never get into the Kingdom of Heaven.”

1 Corinthians 4:6 “It’s important to look at things from God’s point of view.”

Isaiah 46:9-10 “I am God. There is nobody else like Me. There is no other God, except Me. From the beginning, I say what will happen at the end. Long ago, I spoke about future things that have not yet happened. I say this: ‘My purpose will not change. I will do everything that I want to do.’”

2. Embrace God’s Path to Your Glorious Destiny.

Psalm 73:24 “You guide me with Your counsel.”

1 John 3:1-3. “SEE what great love the Father has for us that He would call us His children. And that is what we are. We know that when He comes again, we will be like Him because we will SEE Him as He is. The person who is LOOKING for this to happen will keep himself pure because Christ is pure.”

The right concept leads to right choices which leads to the right control.

Right concept = God’s Truth

controls your mind.

Right choices = God's Spirit
controls your will.

Right control = God's Power
controls your life.

Romans 6:16 “Don’t you realize that you become the slave of whatever you choose to obey? You can be a slave to sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God, which leads to righteous living.”

3. Encompass Your Life with God's Presence and Power.

Psalm 73:25-28 “I desire You more than anything on earth. God remains the strength of my heart; He is mine forever. I have made the Sovereign Lord my shelter.”

**Do what you can, and God will do
what you can’t.**

Psalm 37:5 “Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust Him to help you do it, and He will.”
