



DAILY DEVOTIONAL: DESTINY **PERSPECTIVE**

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or in your Life Group.

February 9: SEE WHAT GOD SEES

Read Jeremiah 1:11–12.

- What spoke to you the most from the sermon “**DESTINY PERSPECTIVE**”? How do you plan to let what you heard this weekend affect your perspective of life?
- Identify a situation where God’s truth conflicts with popular opinion. What response did you choose in that moment, and what influenced it most?
- Where has fear quietly redirected

your obedience? Reflect on a time when obedience required standing alone. What did that experience reveal about your trust in God?

- How does believing God's promise to perform His Word change your confidence in uncertain situations? What courageous step is the Holy Spirit prompting you to take now?

Prayer: Pray and ask God to align your vision with His truth. Confess to Him wherever fear of people has influenced your choices. Ask for courage to obey His Word even when it costs you comfort or approval.

February 10: THE MILK AND HONEY PERSPECTIVE

Read Numbers 14:8–9.

- Rev. Divine said, **“Destiny is not determined by what you face, but by how you see.”** How

would you currently describe your future? Does your future reflect faith or fear?

- Have you ever had past disappointments shaping your expectations? How did you overcome them? Where might you be protecting yourself instead of trusting God?
- Consider how God's delight in you redefines your sense of worth. How would your decisions change if you truly believed this?
- What truth from God's Word counters fear for you? Share with someone at home, work, in your Life Group, or your social media platforms.

Pray this prayer by faith:

“Heavenly Father, remove fear from my heart and renew my perspective. Help me to see Your promises instead of obstacles, and to move forward in faith because You are with me. I ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.”

February 11: WALK BY FAITH.

Read. 2 Corinthians 5:7.

- Rev. Divine shared with us last weekend, “**Destiny favors conviction over consensus.**” What opportunity may have been delayed because of lack of faith in your life?
- Identify areas where you demand clarity before obedience. What fear lies beneath that need for certainty?
- How might faith have led you differently? Where have you seen this proven in your life?
- What step will you take this week to affirm your faith no matter the situation?

Make this faith declaration out loud: “I walk by faith and not by sight. I trust God’s Word above my circumstances. God’s Word directs my steps, and my destiny is secure in Him.”

February 12: REJECT THE SPIRIT OF FEAR

Read 2 Timothy 1:7.

- Think about the various ways fear disguises itself in your life. Does it appear as caution, logic, or over-analysis? How has it cost you?
- What promises of God come to your mind that counter the spirit of fear? Which of His promises have you underutilized?
- Knowing God's truth can overcome fear when used in faith. What truth from God will you declare over your life?

Prayer: Pray and ask God to help you walk by faith and not by sight. Surrender your need for certainty and choose obedience. The Blood of Jesus has overcome every enemy of God's kingdom. This includes fear! Pray in faith and claim victory over fear in your life.

February 13: GIANTS OR PROVISION

- Read Numbers 13:30.
- Identify a challenge that currently feels overwhelming. How have you been describing it in your thoughts and words? What language do you use to describe this challenge? Does it magnify fear or faith?
- How does God's presence change the weight of opposition? What shifts when you remember He is with you?
- How can you identify and overcome the exaggerations of fear? What truth brings the situation back into perspective?
- Rev. Divine taught last weekend, **"Giants look different when God is standing with you."** What does this statement mean to you?

Pray this prayer by faith: “Lord Jesus, open my eyes to see Your glory in every challenge. Shift my focus from giants to Your presence. Amen.”

February 14: STEADFAST IN GOD’S PRESENCE

Read Numbers 14: 24.

- Rev. Divine stated, **“When God is present, risk becomes obedience.”** Have you experienced this truth in your life? What practices help you to remain aware of God’s presence? How has His presence brought you stability through difficult times?
- Reflect on your daily activities. What habits keep God central and which ones need strengthening?
- Identify distractions that pull your focus away. How can you intentionally limit their influence?

Make this faith declaration out loud: “I set the Lord always before me. He is at my right hand, and I will not be moved.”

February 15: LIVE WITH DESTINY CONFIDENCE

Read Psalm 16:8.

- How has your perspective shifted this week after this sermon? Where do you notice growth?
- Examine areas where fear once ruled. What evidence shows faith is now taking its place?
- Are you confident in your choices that affect your destiny? What decisions are now easier because of faith?

- What practices strengthen fearless faith for you? Which one will you commit to consistently?

Prayer: Pray and thank God for strengthening your faith. Ask Him to help you walk boldly and confidently into your destiny.
