Ephesians 2:4-6 “But God is so rich in mercy, and He loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, He gave us life when He raised Christ from the dead. It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved! For He raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.”

Three Truths About God's **Unstoppable Grace**

1. You're Never Too LOST For God's Grace!

Ephesians 2:4-5 “But God is so rich in mercy, and He loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, He gave us life when He raised Christ from the dead.”

Romans 5:12 “When Adam sinned, sin entered the world. Adam's sin brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone sinned.”

Guilt is the starting point for Grace.

James 2:10 “The person who keeps every law of God but makes one little slip is just as guilty as the person who has broken every law there is.”

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

John 5:24 “I tell you the truth, those who listen to My message and believe in God who sent Me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for

their sins, but they have already passed from death into life.”

Micah 7:18 "Who is a God like You, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of His inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy."

2. You're Never Too LOW For God's Grace!

Ephesians 2:5-6 “It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved! For He raised us from the dead along with Christ...”

2 Corinthians 12:9-10 “God said, ‘My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness.’ For when I am weak, then I am strong.”

The basis for God’s blessing on your life is not what you deserve, but what Christ has done for you.

Ephesians 2:8 “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.”

**God doesn't give us what we
deserve – He gives us GRACE.**

John 3:17 “For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.”

Isaiah 50:9-10 “See, the Sovereign Lord is on my side! Who will declare me guilty? All my enemies will be destroyed like old clothes that have been eaten by moths! Who among you fears the Lord and obeys His servant? If you are walking in

darkness, without a ray of light, trust in the Lord and rely on your God.”

3. You're Never Too LATE For God's Grace!

Ephesians 2:6 “...and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.”

2 Corinthians 3:16-17 “Whenever a man turns to the Lord, the covering is taken away and the heart is free where the Spirit of the Lord is.”

**Grace doesn't make you a better
version of your old self.
Grace makes you brand new in
Christ!**

2 Corinthians 5:17 "This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"

Steps to Salvation:

Admit you are a sinner and ask God to forgive you.

1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins to Him, He is faithful and just to forgive

us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.”

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.

Acts 16:31 “Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved.”

Commit yourself to God.

Acts 2:38 “Each of you must repent of your sins and turn to God, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins.”

A Prayer for Salvation

“Dear God, I come to You in the name of Jesus Christ. I ask You to save me today. I confess that I have sinned

against You. Please forgive me of my sins. I believe that Jesus Christ is Your Son. I believe that He died on the cross and rose from the dead so that I might be saved.
