## **Three Truths About God's** **Unstoppable Praise**

### **1. God's Unstoppable Praise**

**MAGNIFIES Your**  
**BLESSINGS.**

Luke 19:37 “All of His followers began  
to shout and sing as they walked along,

praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen.”

The Hebrew word for gratitude is  
**“hakarot ha’tov”**.

**“Hakarot ha’tov”** literally means  
**“recognizing the good”**.

Psalm 103:2-5 “Let all that I am praise the Lord; **may I never forget the good things He does for me.** He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. He redeems me from death and crowns me with love and tender mercies. He fills my life with good things.”

James 1:17 “Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father.”

**I will not allow what I DON'T have to keep me from enjoying what I DO have.**

Proverbs 15:15 “For the despondent, every day brings trouble; **for the happy heart, life is a continual feast.**”

**A grateful heart requires a grateful perspective.**

Romans 8:28 “We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them.”

Psalm 34:3-4 “Oh, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt His name together. I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.”

**2. God’s Unstoppable Praise  
MAGNIFIES Your GOD.**

Luke 19:38 “Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!”

2 Samuel 7:22 “How great you are, O Sovereign Lord! There is no one like You. We have never even heard of another God like You!”

Psalm 19:1 “The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of His hands.”

Romans 1:20 “Through everything God made, people can clearly see His

invisible qualities - His eternal power and divine nature.”

Nehemiah 9:6 “You alone are the LORD. You made the heavens, even the highest heavens, and all their starry host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them. You give life to everything, and the multitudes of heaven worship You.”

Psalm 22:3 “You are holy, O You who inhabits the praises of Israel.”

Philippians 4:11-13 “I have learned to be content no matter what happens to

me. I have learned the secret of being content no matter what happens. I am content whether I am well fed or hungry. I am content whether I have more than enough or not enough. I can do all this by the power of Christ. He gives me strength.”

**Until Christ is all you have, you won't realize Christ is all you need.**

**Our voices should be as LOUD in praise as they are in prayer.**

Psalm 4:7 “You brought me more happiness than a rich harvest of grain and grapes.”

### **3. God’s Unstoppable Praise MAKES You WHOLE.**

Matthew 21:14 “The blind and the lame came to Him in the Temple, and He healed them.”

Psalm 63:3-5 “Your unfailing love is better than life itself; how I praise You! I will praise You as long as I live, lifting up my hands to You in prayer. You satisfy me more than the

richest feast. I will praise You with songs of joy.”

**When PRAISE dominates your attitude then POWER will dominate your life.**
