

May 2: TEST EVERY VOICE.

Read 1 John 4:1.

- Do you test what you hear or accept what feels convincing? Can you distinguish between God's voice and emotional influence?
- What have you accepted without spiritual verification?
- Not everything that sounds spiritual is from God. Discernment is knowing the difference between right and almost right. Are you led by truth or by feelings?

Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith: “Lord, sharpen my discernment. Help me recognize truth and reject deception instantly. In Jesus’ name I pray. Amen.”

May 3: SEE THE HOOK.

Read 2 John 10:10.

- The enemy's mission is clear: to steal, kill, and destroy. He works through subtle compromise. Remember: Every bait carries a hidden hook.
- What in your life looks harmless but is quietly pulling you away from God?
- What repeated struggle reveals a deeper spiritual trap? Are your choices driven by truth or by what feels good in the moment?
- Rev. Divine stated last weekend, “**A temple yielded to God cannot be an abode for the enemy.**” What does this statement mean you? What must you confront today to avoid destruction tomorrow?

Prayer: Ask God to open your eyes to recognize every hidden trap and give you strength to walk away from them.



Daily Devotional: THE BAIT OF COMPROMISE

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or discuss it together in your Life Group.

April 27: THE ENTICEMENT.

Read James 1:14-15.

- What spoke to you the most from the sermon “**THE BAIT OF COMPROMISE**”? How would what you heard change the way you live?
- Where has something “appealing” slowly begun to pull your heart away from God? What desire in you is making certain temptations more attractive?
- In what areas have you justified what God has already warned against? Are you aware of how temptation progresses in your life - or do you only notice after the fall?

Prayer: Awareness is meant to produce repentance, not guilt. Pray and ask God to expose every area where you have compromised. Commit your ways to God and He will direct your path. Join the midweek activities this week. Refer to the bulletin for details.

April 28: THE POWER OF THE EYE.

Read Genesis 3:6.

- What are you consistently exposing your eyes to? What is it producing in your heart?
- Rev. Divine said, “**If the eye does not admire, the heart will not desire.**” What does this statement mean to you?
- Where have your eyes led you into thoughts or actions that are not aligned with God? Are you disciplined in what you watch, or passive in what you allow?
- What must you remove today to protect your future tomorrow?

Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith: “Lord, discipline my eyes. Let my focus draw me closer to You, not away from You. In Jesus’ name I pray. Amen.”

April 29: THE PATH THAT SEEMS RIGHT.

Read Proverbs 14:12.

- Not everything that looks right is right. Are you currently following a path because it feels right or because God confirmed it?
- What decision in your life looks good externally but contradicts God’s Word internally? Where are you ignoring warning signs because you want a certain outcome?
- What “harmless” compromise today could become destruction tomorrow?

Make this declaration in faith: “I walk in God’s truth, not in what seems right. His ways are my ways. He leads me to His promises for me.”

April 30: THE DISGUISE OF OPPORTUNITY.

Read 2 Corinthians 11:14.

- Rev. Divine shared with us last weekend, “**Compromise rarely looks like sin – it looks like opportunity.**” What opportunity in your life feels right but lacks God’s approval?
- What emotional need is making compromise attractive to you right now? Share with your Life Group.
- Are you catching compromise early or only after the damage is done?

Declare by faith out loud: “The word of God lights up my path. I reject every disguised trap. I choose obedience to the word over convenience.”

May 1: PROTECT YOUR INHERITANCE.

Hebrews 12:16–17.

- What are you at risk of losing because of a temporary desire?
- Where have you prioritized immediate comfort over eternal value?
- What is your “birthright” that must be protected at all costs?
- Rev. Divine said, “**What you refuse to discipline today will rise and discipline you.**” Are your daily choices preserving your destiny or eroding it?

Make your faith declaration today: “I will not exchange my destiny for temporary pleasure. I refuse to live outside the will of God for me. My inheritance is secure in God.”
