Romans 8:31-39 “What can we say about all this? If God is on our side, can anyone be against us? God did not keep back His own Son, but He gave Him for us. If God did this, won't He freely give us everything else? If God says His chosen ones are acceptable to Him, can anyone bring charges against them? Or can anyone condemn them? No indeed! Christ died and was raised to life, and now He is at God's right side, speaking to Him for us. Can anything separate us from the love

of Christ? Can trouble, suffering, and hard times, or hunger and nakedness, or danger and death? In everything we have won more than a victory because of Christ who loves us. I am sure that nothing can separate us from God's love - not life or death, not angels or spirits, not the present or the future, and not powers above or powers below. Nothing in all creation can separate us from God's love for us in Christ Jesus our Lord!”

**Three Reasons We Possess God’s
Unstoppable Life Through the
Resurrection of Jesus Christ**

**1. We Possess God’s Unstoppable
Life because Jesus’ Resurrection
gives us ACCESS to GOD.**

Romans 8:32-34 “God did not keep back His own Son, but He gave Him for us. If God did this, won't He freely give us everything else? If God says His chosen ones are acceptable to Him, can anyone bring charges against them? Or can anyone condemn them? No indeed!”

Romans 5:1-2 “Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through Him we have also obtained

access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.”

Ephesians 2:18-19 “For through Him we both have **access** to the Father by one Spirit. From now on you are not strangers and people who are not citizens. You are citizens together with those who belong to God. You belong in God’s family.”

Ephesians 3:11-12 “This was His eternal plan, which He carried out through Christ Jesus our Lord. Because of Christ and our faith in Him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God’s presence – we have

access with confidence through our faith in Him.”

When you have access to God, you have access to everything He is. And EVERYTHING HE IS, IS EVERYTHING YOU NEED.

Hebrews 4:16 “With Jesus as our high priest, we can feel free to come before God’s throne where there is grace. There we receive mercy and kindness to help us when we need it.”

2 Corinthians 3:4, 12-13, 16, 18 “Such is the confidence that we have through

Christ toward God. Since we have such a hope, we are very bold, not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face. But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.”

When your Maker becomes your mirror, you see yourself as you ought to see yourself.

Romans 5:9-10 “Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more

shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him! For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to Him through the death of His Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through His life!"

2. We Possess God's Unstoppable Life because Jesus' Resurrection gives us AUTHORITY from GOD.

Romans 8:37 "In everything we have won more than a victory because of Christ who loves us."

Luke 9:1-2 “Jesus called together His twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases. Then He sent them out to tell everyone about the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick.”

Luke 10:19 Jesus said, “I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you.”

Colossians 2:9-10 “For in Christ there is all of God in a human body; so you have everything when you have Christ, and you

are filled with God through your union with Christ. He is the highest Ruler, with authority over every other power.”

Ephesians 1:21-23 “Now He is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else - not only in this world but also in the world to come. God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made Him head over all things for the benefit of the church. And the church is His body; it is made full and complete by Christ, who fills all things everywhere with Himself.”

**Boldness is a behavior born out of
belief.**

Luke 24:46-49, “Yes, it was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day. It was also written that this message would be proclaimed in the authority of His name to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem: ‘There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.’ You are witnesses of all these things. And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as My Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven.”

**3. We Possess God's Unstoppable
Life because Jesus' Resurrection
keeps us with the AGAPE LOVE of
GOD.**

Romans 8:38-39 "For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

1 John 3:1 "See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be

called children of God! And that is what we are!”

Exodus 34:14 “He is a God who is passionate about His relationship with you.”

Ephesians 1:4 “Even before He made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes.”

GRACE is not based on what you’ve done. It’s based on what Jesus has done.

Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
