Three Truths About God's Unstoppable Power from the Resurrection of Jesus

- 1. God's Power is Unstoppable
because His Power is
UNLIMITED!**

John 1:1-5 “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.”

Psalm 33:6-9 “The Lord merely spoke, and the heavens were created. He breathed the word, and all the stars were born. He assigned the sea its boundaries and locked the oceans in

vast reservoirs. Let the whole world fear the Lord, and let everyone stand in awe of Him. For when He spoke, the world began! It appeared at His command.”

Matthew 4:23-24 “Jesus traveled throughout the region of Galilee, teaching in the synagogues and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom. And He healed every kind of disease and illness. And whatever their sickness or disease, or if they were demon possessed or epileptic or paralyzed - He healed them all.”

Matthew 12:28-29 “But if I am casting out demons by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God has arrived among you. For who is powerful enough to enter the house of a strong man like Satan and plunder his goods? Only someone even stronger - someone who could tie him up and then plunder his house.”

1 Corinthians 15:26 “And the last enemy to be destroyed is death.”

Acts 2:24: “But God raised Him from the dead, freeing Him from the agony of death, because it was **impossible**

**for death to keep its hold on
Him.”**

Romans 6:9 “Christ was raised from
the dead, and we know that He cannot
die again. Death has no power over
Him now.”

**2. God’s Power is Unstoppable
because His Power is
UNENDING!**

Hebrews 1:8, 10-12 “But to the Son He says, ‘Your throne, O God, endures forever and ever.’ He also says, ‘In the beginning, O Lord, You laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You remain; they will all wear out like a garment. You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But You remain the same, and Your years will never end.’”

Hebrews 12:27-28 “This means that all of creation will be shaken and removed, so that only unshakable

things will remain. Since we are receiving a Kingdom that is unshakable, let us be thankful and please God by worshiping Him with holy fear and awe.”

Malachi 3:6 “I am the Lord, and I do not change.”

Hebrews 13:8 “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.”

Matthew 24:35 “Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away.”

**3. God's Power is Unstoppable
because His Power is
UNDEFEATED!**

Isaiah 9:7 “Power and peace will be in
His kingdom and will continue to grow
forever.”

Luke 17:21 Jesus said, “The Kingdom
of God is within you.”

Luke 12:32 “So don’t be afraid, little flock. For it gives your Father great happiness to give you the Kingdom.”

Colossians 1:13 “For He has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of His dear Son.”

1 Thessalonians 2:12 “We pleaded with you, encouraged you, and urged you to live your lives in a way that God would consider worthy. For He called you to share in His Kingdom and glory.”

Romans 8:11 “The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, He will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.”

Romans 6:3-5 “Just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives. Since we have been united with Him in His death, we will also be raised to life as He was.”
