

**May 15: SPEAK LIFE.**

**Read** Isaiah 59:21.

- What are you speaking over your life and your lineage? Where have your words reinforced negativity instead of faith?
- What have you declared that needs to be reversed?
- Are your prayers shaping destiny or reacting to circumstances?
- What will your words produce if nothing changes?

**Make this declaration in faith:** “My words align with God’s will. I speak life, purpose, and destiny. My voice builds and does not destroy. My declarations shape generations.”

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**May 16: INTERCEDE FOR GENERATIONS.**

**Read** Romans 8:26–27

- Rev. Adeline stated last weekend, “**God-given revelation is for intercession for the nations and generations.**” What does this statement mean to you?
- Who are you standing in the gap for right now? Where has prayer been replaced with worry or silence?
- What burden has God placed on your heart that you have ignored? Are you praying from emotion or from the Spirit?
- What will change if you begin to intercede consistently?

**Prayer:** Ask God to give you a burden for others and for your lineage. Pray for the Spirit to lead your prayers beyond your understanding. Ask for consistency and power in intercession that brings transformation.



**Daily Devotional BREAKING THE BAIT FOR GENERATIONS**

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or discuss it together in your Life Group.

**May 10: WHAT DO YOU REALLY LOVE?**

**Read** Deuteronomy 6:4-5.

- What spoke to you the most from the sermon “**BREAKING THE BAIT FOR GENERATIONS**”? How would what you heard change the way you live?
- What has your deepest affection right now: God or something else? What competes with God for your time, attention, and loyalty?
- Where has your love been divided without you confronting it? What “harmless” attachment is quietly becoming idolatry?
- If your life were examined, what would it prove you love most?

**Pray:** Ask God to expose every competing affection in your heart. Pray for a deeper, undivided love for God above all else. Ask for grace to put God first in your desires, decisions, and daily life.

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## May 11: BREAK THE BAIT.

**Read** 1 John 2:15–16.

- Rev. Adeline said, “**Intercede from the spirit not from the flesh.**” What does this statement mean to you?
- What specific bait has the enemy used repeatedly in your life? Where have you normalized what God has called you to break?
- What pattern in your life must stop completely? What are you tolerating that will affect those coming after you? If you don’t break it now, who will inherit it?

**Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith:** “Lord Jesus, reveal every hidden trap and recurring pattern. Give me the strength to confront and destroy them completely. Help me refuse compromise in every form. Let freedom begin with me. Amen.”

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## May 12: WHAT ARE YOU PASSING ON?

**Read** 2 Timothy 1:5.

- What spiritual patterns are you transferring intentionally or unintentionally?
- What are others learning from your life that you are not saying out loud?
- Are you modeling devotion or just talking about it? What must change in you before it can change in the next generation?
- If your life is copied, will it lead others closer to God?

**Make this declaration in faith:** “I will pass on genuine faith. My life reflects truth, consistency, and devotion. I model what I believe. I raise a generation that loves God.”

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## May 13: SEE YOUR ASSIGNMENT

**Read** Genesis 25:23.

- Do you see people as they are or as what they can become in God?
- What revelation has God shown you that you have not acted on? Where have you reduced your calling to something too small?
- What responsibility are you avoiding concerning your generation?
- If you don’t rise, what will remain unchanged?

**Declare by faith out loud:** “I carry revelation for my generation. I see beyond the present into God’s purpose. I am positioned to impact nations. My life has generational significance.”

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## May 14: GUARD THE SEED.

**Read** Malachi 2:15.

- Rev. Adeline said, “**Break these baits by loving God and teaching all connected to you to do the same.**” What are you doing to protect what God has entrusted to you?
- Where has carelessness opened doors the enemy can exploit? What must you guard more intentionally: your heart, your home, or your influence?
- What are you building that will outlive you? Are you raising a godly seed or just maintaining appearances?

**Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith:** “Father, help me protect what You have placed in my care. Strengthen me to build intentionally. Let my life produce a lasting spiritual legacy. Preserve everything You have given me in Jesus’ mighty name. Amen.”

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
