

May 30: Filled With the Holy Spirit.

Read Ephesians 5:15-20.

- What does it mean for a believer to live under the guidance and influence of the Holy Spirit?
- What attitudes, habits, or environments can weaken spiritual fire and sensitivity?
- How does the Holy Spirit help believers grow in wisdom, boldness, and holiness?
- In what areas of your life do you need the Holy Spirit to take full control?
- How can you intentionally stay spiritually full and connected to God daily?

Make this declaration in faith: “I will not live spiritually empty. The Holy Spirit fills me with power, wisdom, boldness, and holiness. My life shall reflect the character and fire of Christ everywhere I go.”

May 31: Carry the Fire of God.

Read Romans 12:1-21.

- What does it mean to remain spiritually fervent in a world full of distractions?
- What are the signs of spiritual coldness, weariness, or loss of passion for God?
- How can believers maintain consistency, discipline, and excitement in serving God?
- Why is it important for your life to reflect God’s fire and passion to others?
- What practical steps can help you remain spiritually strong and committed every day?

Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith: “Lord, keep my heart burning for You. Let me never grow cold, distracted, or weary in serving You. Fill me with fresh passion, strength, and endurance to carry Your fire everywhere I go, in Jesus’ name. Amen.”

Daily Devotional

May 25: Lord, Revive Me Again.

Read Psalm 85:1-7.

- In what areas of your spiritual life do you feel distant, dry, or disconnected from God?
- Have you allowed disappointment, routine, fear, or distractions to weaken your passion for prayer and worship?
- What does true spiritual revival look like in the life of a believer who is fully surrendered to God?
- How can spending intentional time in prayer restore joy, hunger, and sensitivity to God’s presence?
- What changes would happen in your life if your relationship with God became your highest priority again?

Pray this prayer in faith: “Father, revive my heart. Remove every form of spiritual dryness and awaken a fresh hunger for Your presence. Let my love for You burn stronger every day, in Jesus’ name. Amen.”

May 26: Watch and Pray.

Read Matthew 26:36-46.

- Are you spiritually watchful or easily distracted? Why is spiritual alertness important in your current season of life?
- What distractions, temptations, or pressures have been pulling your attention away from God?
- How does neglecting prayer weaken spiritual strength and sensitivity?
- What practical habits can help you remain spiritually watchful and disciplined every day?
- In what areas do you need God's strength to overcome temptation and remain faithful?

Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith: "Holy Spirit, guide my decisions and correct my path. Deliver me from relying on my own reasoning. Help me seek Your will in everything I do. Lead me in the path that brings life. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen."

May 27: Rekindle the Fire Within.

Read 2 Timothy 1:6-10.

- What gifts, talents, or spiritual callings has God placed inside you that need to be developed?
- Has fear, discouragement, or comfort caused you to neglect your spiritual growth?
- What habits help believers remain spiritually passionate and consistent in serving God?
- How can you intentionally use your gifts to impact others and glorify God?
- What areas of your life need fresh spiritual fire and renewed passion today?

Make this declaration in faith: "The fire of God within me will not go out. I am stirred, strengthened, and empowered for God's purpose."

May 28: Pursue God Wholeheartedly.

Read Jeremiah 29:11-14.

- What distractions or priorities compete for your attention more than God?
- What does it truly mean to seek God with your whole heart and not just casually?
- How can prayer, worship, and studying God's Word deepen your relationship with Him?
- What changes in a believer's life when God becomes their greatest pursuit?
- What steps can you take to become more intentional in your walk with God?

Declare by faith out loud: "My heart belongs fully to God. I will pursue Him daily and encounter His presence continually."

May 29: Build a Lifestyle of Prayer.

Read Luke 18:1-8.

- What challenges have affected your consistency in prayer?
- Why do many believers become discouraged while waiting for answers from God?
- How does persistent prayer strengthen faith, patience, and spiritual endurance?
- What changes when prayer becomes a daily lifestyle instead of something done only during problems?
- How can you create intentional time each day to grow stronger in prayer?

Pray this prayer from a sincere heart of faith: "Heavenly Father, teach me to remain faithful in prayer. Let prayer become the foundation of my daily life. Strengthen my faith, renew my patience, and help me trust You even while I wait. I ask this in Jesus' name. Amen."
