

- One of the most common ways people quit is by compromising. Rather than maintaining a standard of excellence, we often do an inferior job. Does this describe you? Are you compromising in any area of your speech, your thoughts, or your actions?
- In today's Bible reading, we are challenged to do EVERYTHING for the glory of the Lord. Work as if you are working for God. Whatever you do or say should be done and said as a representative of Jesus Christ. Are there areas where you have settled for less than God's best?
- How would your life be different if everything you did was truly for God's glory?

**Prayer:** Ask God to show you areas of compromise in your life. Pray for His grace to live your life fully for His glory.

### **June 14: Relentless Faith, Relentless Pursuit.**

Read Romans 5:1-11.

- How has God's relentless love shaped your faith journey? What promise from God are you still believing for?
- Where are you tempted to quit instead of persevering? How does knowing that God never gives up on you strengthen your faith?
- Pastor Whitcomb said, "ADJUST your faith to ADVANCE in faith." What would the relentless pursuit of God look like in your daily life?
- We become relentless in our pursuit of God and His will when we realize how relentless He has been in pursuing us. He never gives up on us. He never stops loving us. Jesus paid for our redemption with His own blood. Let the relentless love of God for you fill you with relentless faith today!
- Declare by faith these truths from today's Bible reading: "Jesus has brought me to a place of privilege. I will share in God's glory. God loves me deeply. I am saved from condemnation. I am a friend of God."

**Prayer:** Take time to meditate on God's relentless love, mercy, and grace for your life. Ask Him to open your eyes and take you to a new level of relentless faith as you pursue Him.

### **Daily Devotional for ADVANCE IN FAITH**

Here is a Daily Devotional to enable you to make the most out of this sermon. You may use it for your personal growth or discuss it together in your Life Group.

### **June 8: Faith for the Impossible.**

Read Joshua 10:7-14.

- What was the one thing that spoke to you the most during the sermon last weekend? How will what you heard affect your life?
- Pastor Whitcomb said, "**Great faith in God is the key to a great life.**" What part of Joshua's bold faith challenges you the most?
- Are there any "impossible situations" in your life that need God's intervention right now? What lessons can you take from Joshua's life to overcome those situations?
- What is one area where fear has kept you from advancing in faith? How has God proven His faithfulness to you in previous battles? What would you attempt for God if you knew failure was impossible?

**Prayer:** Pray for courage to face impossible situations. Thank God for past victories. Ask God for bold faith to advance.

### **June 9: Seeing Through the Eyes of Revelation.**

Read Hebrews 10:19-39.

- Last weekend, Pastor Whitcomb shared with us, "You must realign yourself to God's revelation in order to get God's results." What does this statement mean to you?
- When we are strong in faith, it empowers us to advance. Name three truths in today's Bible reading that motivate you to advance in faith.
- What activities or habits do you currently have that strengthen

your faith and help you believe what God says? How can you increase your faith-building activities right now?

- What activities or habits do you currently have that weaken your faith and hinder you from believing what He says? How can you eliminate these negative influences?

**Pray from a sincere heart:** “Lord Jesus, increase my faith! Help me to do things that will build my faith and deliver me from the things that weaken my faith. Amen!”

### **June 10: Guarding the Truth.**

Read 2 Thessalonians 2.

- Prophecy and spiritual revelations abound in the church today. But the Bible warns us that we should not be deceived by false revelation. Instead, we must hold firmly to the truth of God’s Word. True faith is always built on the truth of God’s Word. Why is discernment essential for believers today?
- Pastor Whitcomb shared this powerful truth, “**The Bible is your title deed to the promises of God. The more you know God’s Word, the bolder you will be in faith.**” Are you spending sufficient time focused on God’s Word every day so that you can advance in faith?
- What practical steps can you take this month to increase your exposure to God’s revelation in the Bible? How can you build your knowledge of God’s truth so that you are protected from false revelation?

**Prayer:** Ask God to deliver you from all deception and false revelations. Pray for wisdom and discernment so that you will know the truth. Pray, “Lord, keep me through your Word. Protect me by your Truth. Guide me with pure revelation. Amen.”

### **June 11: Realignment Before Breakthrough.**

Read 1 Peter 1.

- Pastor Whitcomb said, “**Revelation without realignment leads to regret.**” What does this statement mean to you? Have you ever had a revelation of what God wanted to do, but not achieved it because you didn’t realign your life to accomplish it?

- What dreams and visions from God do you have for your life? What realignments do you need to make to see God’s plan for your life come to pass?
- How do trials help strengthen your faith? What role do trials have in forcing you to realign yourself to succeed? Pray for God’s grace to enable you to pass through trials and come out stronger in faith.

**Make this declaration in faith:** “I align my thoughts, actions, and priorities with God's purpose. I will not delay obedience. God's plan for my life will be fulfilled.”

### **June 12: The Shift That Unlocks the Supernatural.**

Read Galatians 5.

- In his sermon, Pastor Whitcomb taught us, “**There must be a SHIFT in your life to see the SUPERNATURAL in your life.**” What does this statement mean to you? What needs to shift in your life now, so that the supernatural power of God will be released to you?
- How is the Holy Spirit calling you to grow in this season? What limitations have you accepted that God wants to remove?
- Are your current goals large enough to require God's intervention? If your vision for your life can be accomplished in your own power, then your vision is too small! Ask God to open your eyes to see His plan for you. Begin to adjust now so that you can accomplish great things for God.

**Pray this prayer:** “Lord, shift my thinking, my attitude, and my conduct so that I can be a channel for the supernatural. Remove limitations from my life so that I can excel in my destiny, in Jesus’ Name. Amen!”

### **June 13: No More Compromise.**

Read Colossians 3.

- Pastor Whitcomb shared with us in his sermon, “**Don’t ask, ‘How can I make this happen?’ Ask, ‘How can I align with God to see this happen?’**” Let this question guide your decisions and see God work wonders in your life.
